SUMMARY—Authorizes a board of county commissioners to enter into a contract to provide the residents of the county with discounts on prescription drugs. (BDR 20-530)

AN ACT relating to counties; authorizing a board of county commissioners to enter into a contract or other agreement to provide the residents of the county with discounts on prescription drugs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 A board of county commissioners is authorized under existing law to enact
2 laws to protect the public health. (NRS 244.357) This bill specifically authorizes a
3 board of county commissioners to enter into a contract or other agreement to
4 provide the residents of the county with discounts on prescription drugs.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 244 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***A board of county commissioners may enter into a contract or
4 other agreement to provide the residents of the county with a
5 reduction in the price of a drug or medicine dispensed by a
6 pharmacy pursuant to a prescription. The contract or other
7 agreement may, without limitation, provide for the participation of
8 the county in a program that provides prescription drugs or
9 medicines at a discounted price.***
