
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 610—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

MAY 1, 2007

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation for use as matching money to reduce or retire the existing mortgage on the Veterans Guest House, Inc. (BDR S-1464)

AN ACT making an appropriation for use as matching money to reduce or retire the existing mortgage on the Veterans Guest House, Inc.; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Veterans Guest House, Inc., the sum of
3 \$300,000 for use as matching money to reduce or retire the existing
4 mortgage on the Veterans Guest House in Reno, Nevada.

5 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
6 the Veterans Guest House, Inc., shall:

7 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
8 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each
9 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
10 from the date on which the money was received by the Veterans
11 Guest House, Inc., through December 1, 2008; and

12 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
13 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each
14 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
15 from the date on which the money was received by the Veterans
16 Guest House, Inc., through June 30, 2009; and



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1 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
2 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
3 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
4 otherwise, of the Veterans Guest House, Inc., regardless of their
5 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to
6 conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
7 subsection 1.

8 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
9 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
10 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
11 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
12 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
13 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
14 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
15 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
16 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
17 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

18 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
