
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 613—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Family Development Foundation for domestic violence prevention programs. (BDR S-1450)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Family Development Foundation for domestic violence prevention programs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Family Development Foundation for domestic
3 violence prevention programs and services in southern Nevada:
4 For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$1,300,000
5 For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$1,300,000
6 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
7 the Family Development Foundation shall:
8 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
11 from the date on which the money was received by the Family
12 Development Foundation through December 1, 2008;
13 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
14 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each
15 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
16 from the date on which the money was received by the Family
17 Development Foundation through June 30, 2009; and



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1 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
2 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
3 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
4 otherwise, of the Family Development Foundation, regardless of
5 their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary
6 to conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
7 subsection 1.

8 **Sec. 2.** Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of
9 this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not
10 be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal
11 years by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
12 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
13 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
14 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
15 September 19, 2008, and September 18, 2009, respectively, by
16 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity
17 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
18 and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
19 September 19, 2008, and September 18, 2009, respectively.

20 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.

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
