

A.B. 622

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 622—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS**MAY 23, 2007**

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Department of Wildlife for the conservation and restoration of fish and wildlife and their habitat. (BDR S-1442)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Wildlife for the conservation and restoration of fish and wildlife and their habitat; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:**

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department
2 of Wildlife for the purpose of benefiting fish, wildlife and their
3 habitat:

4 For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$500,000
5 For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$500,000

6 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be expended
7 by the Department for the purposes and in accordance with the
8 requirements of the State Wildlife Grants Program of the United
9 States Fish and Wildlife Service or any similar federal program
10 established pursuant to federal law, rule or regulation for the
11 purpose of benefiting fish and wildlife and their habitat.

12 3. Any balance of the sums appropriated by subsection 1
13 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be
14 committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal
15 years by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
16 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
17 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated



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1 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September
2 19, 2008, and September 18, 2009, respectively, by either the entity
3 to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the
4 money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
5 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 19, 2008,
6 and September 18, 2009, respectively.

7 **Sec. 2.** The appropriations made by the provisions of this act
8 are intended to finance ongoing expenditures of state agencies, and
9 the expenditures financed with those appropriations must be
10 included as base budget expenditures in the proposed budget for the
11 Executive Branch of State Government for the 2009-2011 biennium.

12 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
