2 average of 3.45; and

3 WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1992, Galena High School has
4 won either a league, regional or state championship in every sport in
5 which their athletes have participated and, in 2006, received the
6 Class 4A Award of Excellence in Academics, Athletics and
7 Citizenship from the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association;

9 WHEREAS, On February 23, 2007, the Grizzlies boys' basketball
10 team proved their commitment to teamwork and athletic excellence
11 by winning the 2007 Class 4A State Championship; and

12 WHEREAS, Entering the fourth quarter tied at 41 points each,
13 with the lead changing hands eight times in the last quarter, the
14 Mojave Rattlers of North Las Vegas were ahead of the Grizzlies,
15 51-49, with 2 minutes 38 seconds to go; and

16 WHEREAS, In what Galena Coach Tom Maurer called "a great
17 chess match," and with only a little more than a minute left in the
18 game, the Grizzlies pulled ahead with a three-pointer, winning the
19 game at the final buzzer, 54-51; and

20 WHEREAS, A friend and fellow coach told Coach Maurer in the
21 locker room, "You can write things in the sand, and that blows
22 away, but this one's etched in stone"; now, therefore, be it
