ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Creating an  
interim study concerning environmental pollutants and  
global warming.

1     RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
2     SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is hereby  
3     directed to appoint an interim committee composed of three  
4     members of the Assembly and three members of the Senate, one of  
5     whom must be appointed as chairman of the committee, to conduct  
6     an interim study of the effects of environmental pollutants and  
7     global warming on this State; and be it further

8         RESOLVED, That the study must consider environmental  
9     protection, disease prevention and source reduction as these efforts  
10    are impacted by the presence of mercury, silica and other  
11    environmental pollutants in this State; and be it further

12      RESOLVED, That the study must include a review of the federal  
13    and state regulation of environmental pollutants in this State and  
14    look at what can be done about the effects of global warming on the  
15    State of Nevada; and be it further

16      RESOLVED, That the study must also include consideration of  
17    the extent to which industry in this State and the residents of this  
18    State may be contributing to global warming and what steps might  
19    be taken to reduce our contribution to global warming; and be it  
20    further

21      RESOLVED, That the committee shall submit its findings, and  
22    any recommendations for legislation that are approved by a majority  
23    of the members of the Assembly and a majority of the members of
