1 WHEREAS, The FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of
2 Science and Technology) Robotics Competition Championship was
3 held at the Georgia Dome in Atlanta, Georgia, on April 12, 13 and
4 14 of this year; and

5 WHEREAS, FIRST is a nonprofit charitable organization that
6 offers innovative programs that encourage students to pursue

1 opportunities in science, technology, engineering and mathematics;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, More than 1,300 high school teams from the United
4 States and six other nations, including Brazil, Canada, Israel,
5 Mexico, the Netherlands and the United Kingdom, competed in
6 various regional competitions to earn an invitation to the FIRST
7 Robotics Competition Championship; and

8 WHEREAS, Teams of students were required to build robots from
9 kits consisting of hundreds of parts; and

10 WHEREAS, This year's game, called "Rack 'N' Roll" tested the
11 students and the ability of their robots to hang inflated colored tubes
12 on pegs configured in rows and columns on a 10-foot high center
13 "rack" structure, to program a robotic vision system to navigate the
14 robot and to lift other robots more than 4 feet off the floor; and

15 WHEREAS, The Cimarron-Memorial High School's robotics
16 team, known as the "High Rollers," was part of a three-team
17 alliance, including "Bobcat Robotics" of South Windsor High
18 School from South Windsor, Connecticut, and "Gompei and the
19 H.E.R.D." of the Massachusetts Academy of Math and Science from
20 Worcester, Massachusetts, that was awarded first place in the
21 FIRST Robotics Competition Championship; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
23 SENATE CONCURRING, That the members of the Nevada
24 Legislature hereby congratulate the "High Rollers" Robotics Team
25 of Cimarron-Memorial High School for winning the FIRST
