ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Directing the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study of issues relating to elections.

1 WHEREAS, Participation in the election process is an important
2 right for residents of Nevada; and

3 WHEREAS, The State of Nevada, through the Nevada
4 Legislature, the Secretary of State and various local clerk and
5 registrar offices, has the duty to ensure that all Nevadans have
6 access to participation in the election process; and

7 WHEREAS, An interim study would provide a much needed
8 comprehensive review of issues related to elections to determine
9 whether existing statutes are sufficient in providing Nevadans with
10 such access; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
12 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is hereby
13 directed to appoint an interim committee to examine the election
14 process and the administration of elections in the State; and be it
15 further

16 RESOLVED, That the interim committee must be composed of
17 six Legislators, one of whom must be appointed as chairman of the
18 committee, as follows:

19 1. The Chairman of the Senate Standing Committee on
20 Legislative Operations and Elections;

1 2. The Chairman of the Assembly Standing Committee on
2 Elections, Procedures, Ethics, and Constitutional Amendments;
3 3. One member appointed by the Majority Leader of the
4 Senate;
5 4. One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
6 Senate;
7 5. One member appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly; and
8 6. One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
9 Assembly; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the study must include, without limitation, an
11 examination of issues relating to:

- 12 1. The initiative and referendum process;
- 13 2. Voting by mail;
- 14 3. Challenging a person who is applying to vote;
- 15 4. The order of listing offices, candidates and questions on
16 ballots;
- 17 5. Providing for voter registration on the day of a primary or
18 general election;
- 19 6. Voting by absent ballot;
- 20 7. Voting by provisional ballot;
- 21 8. Changing the dates of elections held in cities located in a
22 county whose population is 400,000 or more; and
- 23 9. National elections; and be it further

24 RESOLVED, That any recommended legislation proposed by the
25 interim committee be approved by a majority of the members of the
26 Senate and a majority of the members of the Assembly appointed to
27 the committee; and be it further

28 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall submit a
29 report of the results of the study and any recommended legislation to
30 the 75th Session of the Nevada Legislature.
