1 WHEREAS, The month of February 2007 has been designated as  
2 Career and Technical Education Month by the Association for

4 WHEREAS, Profound economic and technological changes in our  
5 society are reflected in the structure and nature of our workforce,  
6 thereby placing new and additional responsibilities on our
