ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION—Urging the Secretary of the
Interior to fully fund the interagency airtanker base
programs for wildland fire suppression in Minden and
Stead.

1 WHEREAS, The United States Department of the Interior,
2 through the Bureau of Land Management, has provided vital fire
3 suppression services to the State of Nevada; and

4 WHEREAS, These services include air support for wildland fire
5 suppression in northern Nevada through interagency airtanker base
6 operations at the Minden-Tahoe and Reno Stead Airports; and

7 WHEREAS, The areas of service include the forests and
8 watershed surrounding Lake Tahoe, one of the nation's premiere
9 natural treasures, and the wildland urban interface along the Sierra
10 Front in both Nevada and California; and

11 WHEREAS, In July 2006, Nevada ranked first in the nation in the
12 amount of wildland acreage burned by wildfire in the United States;
13 and



1 WHEREAS, The Federal Government owns and manages 87
2 percent of the land in Nevada; and

3 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Land Management has provided
4 exemplary air support for fighting the wildland fires which have
5 threatened Nevada's residents, private property, public lands and
6 other valuable natural resources; and

7 WHEREAS, The Sierra Front has complex and challenging
8 conditions that generate volatile and high-intensity wildland fires
9 which are fought over rugged terrain, and airtankers are a critical
10 component of the fight, being used primarily for initial attack and
11 support; and

12 WHEREAS, Continued funding for the full operation of the
13 interagency airtanker base programs in Minden and Stead with
14 single-engine airtankers that can provide the quick response needed
15 for early suppression of a wildland fire is critical; and

16 WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has the authority to
17 authorize the expenditure of money to provide full funding for the
18 interagency airtanker base programs; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY AND SENATE OF THE STATE OF
20 NEVADA, JOINTLY, That the members of the 74th Session of the
21 Nevada Legislature hereby urge the Secretary of the Interior to fully
22 fund the interagency airtanker base programs for wildland fire
23 suppression in Minden and Stead; and be it further

24 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and
25 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Vice President of the United
26 States as the presiding officer of the United States Senate, the
27 Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Secretary of the
28 Interior and each member of the Nevada Congressional Delegation;
29 and be it further

30 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon
31 passage.
