AN ACT relating to the Legislature; revising provisions relating to
the effective dates of certain laws and joint resolutions;
and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

- 1 Existing law provides that every law and joint resolution passed by the
2 Legislature becomes effective on October 1 following its passage, unless the law or
3 joint resolution specifically prescribes a different effective date. (NRS 218.530)
4 **Section 1** of this bill provides that any provision of a bill or joint resolution, other
5 than a constitutional amendment, that requires the adoption or modification of an
6 ordinance by a local government becomes effective on October 1 following its
7 passage unless the Legislature declares that an emergency exists and that an earlier
8 effective date is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
9 health or safety.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 218.530 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 218.530 **1.** Every law and joint resolution passed by the
3 Legislature becomes effective on October 1 following its passage,



1 unless the law or joint resolution specifically prescribes a different
2 effective date.

3 ***2. Any provision of a bill or joint resolution, other than a***
4 ***constitutional amendment, that requires the adoption or***
5 ***modification of an ordinance by a local government becomes***
6 ***effective on October 1 following its passage unless the Legislature***
7 ***declares that an emergency exists and that an earlier effective date***
8 ***is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,***
9 ***health or safety.***
