

SENATE BILL NO. 121—SENATOR RHOADS

FEBRUARY 20, 2007

Referred to Committee on Government Affairs

SUMMARY—Amends the Charter of the City of Carlin to change the time for election of certain officers. (BDR S-312)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.
Effect on the State: No.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets [omitted-material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the City of Carlin; providing for the general municipal election to be held on the date for the state general election; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 The existing Charter of the City of Carlin provides that the general municipal
2 election occurs on the Tuesday after the first Monday in June of odd-numbered
3 years. (Carlin City Charter § 5.010) This bill amends the Charter to change the date
4 for the general municipal election to coincide with the date for the state general
5 election which is held in November of even-numbered years.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Section 1.060 of the Charter of the City of Carlin,
2 being chapter 344, Statutes of Nevada 1971, as last amended by
3 chapter 515, Statutes of Nevada 1997, at page 2449, is hereby
4 amended to read as follows:

5 Sec. 1.060 Elective offices: Vacancies. Except as
6 otherwise provided in NRS 268.325:

7 1. A vacancy in the Board of Councilmen or in the office
8 of Mayor must be filled by a majority vote of the members of
9 the Board of Councilmen within 30 days after the occurrence



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1 of the vacancy. A person may be selected to fill a prospective
2 vacancy in the Board before the vacancy occurs. In such a
3 case, each member of the Board, except any member whose
4 term of office expires before the occurrence of the vacancy,
5 may participate in any action taken by the Board pursuant to
6 this section. The appointee must have the same qualifications
7 as are required of the elective official.

8 2. No such appointment extends beyond the first
9 Monday in ~~July~~ *January* after the next municipal election,
10 at which election the ~~office~~ :

11 (a) *Office* must be filled for the remaining unexpired term
12 ~~;~~ *or*

13 (b) *Successor to the previously vacated seat will be*
14 *selected,*

15 *as appropriate.*

16 **Sec. 2.** Section 2.010 of the Charter of the City of Carlin,
17 being chapter 344, Statutes of Nevada 1971, as amended by chapter
18 98, Statutes of Nevada 1977, at page 203, is hereby amended to read
19 as follows:

20 Sec. 2.010 Board of Councilmen: Qualifications;
21 election; term of office; salary.

22 1. The legislative power of the City is vested in a Board
23 of Councilmen consisting of four Councilmen and a Mayor.

24 2. The Mayor and Councilmen ~~shall~~ *must* be:

25 (a) Bona fide residents of the City for at least 2 years
26 prior to their election.

27 (b) Qualified electors within the City.

28 3. All Councilmen, including the Mayor, ~~shall~~ *must* be
29 voted upon by the registered voters of the City at large and ,
30 *except as otherwise provided in section 5.010*, shall serve for
31 terms of 4 years.

32 4. The Mayor and Councilmen first holding office under
33 this Charter shall each receive a monthly salary of \$35 during
34 the terms for which they were elected, selected or appointed.
35 Thereafter, subject to the provisions of subsection 5 of section
36 2.090, the Mayor and Councilmen shall receive a salary in an
37 amount fixed by the Board of Councilmen.

38 **Sec. 3.** Section 5.010 of the Charter of the City of Carlin,
39 being chapter 344, Statutes of Nevada 1971, at page 615, is hereby
40 amended to read as follows:

41 Sec. 5.010 General municipal elections.

42 1. On the Tuesday after the ~~1st~~ *first* Monday in June
43 ~~[1973, and at each successive interval of 4 years thereafter,]~~
44 *2007*, there ~~shall~~ *must* be elected by the qualified voters of
45 the City, at a general election to be held for that purpose, two



1 Councilmen ~~[who shall]~~, *both of whom* hold office ~~[for a~~
2 ~~period of 4 years and]~~ until their successors have been elected
3 and qualified ~~[.]~~ *pursuant to subsection 3.*

4 2. On the Tuesday after the ~~[1st]~~ *first* Monday in June
5 ~~[1975, and at each successive interval of 4 years thereafter,]~~
6 *2007*, there ~~[shall]~~ *must* be elected by the qualified voters of
7 the City, at a general election to be held for that purpose, a
8 Mayor and two Councilmen, ~~[who shall]~~ *all of whom* hold
9 office ~~[for a period of 4 years and]~~ until their successors have
10 been elected and qualified ~~[.]~~ *pursuant to subsection 4.*

11 3. *On the Tuesday after the first Monday in November*
12 *2008, and at each successive interval of 4 years thereafter,*
13 *there must be elected by the qualified voters of the City, at a*
14 *general election to be held for that purpose, two*
15 *Councilmen, both of whom hold office for a period of 4*
16 *years and until their successors have been elected and*
17 *qualified.*

18 4. *On the Tuesday after the first Monday in November*
19 *2010, and at each successive interval of 4 years thereafter,*
20 *there must be elected by the qualified voters of the City, at a*
21 *general election to be held for that purpose, a Mayor and*
22 *two Councilmen, all of whom hold office for a period of 4*
23 *years and until their successors have been elected and*
24 *qualified.*

25 **Sec. 4.** Section 5.090 of the Charter of the City of Carlin,
26 being chapter 344, Statutes of Nevada 1971, at page 616, is hereby
27 amended to read as follows:

28 Sec. 5.090 Election returns; canvass; certificates of
29 election; entry of officers upon duties; tie vote procedure.

30 1. The election returns from any municipal election shall
31 be filed with the City Clerk, who shall immediately place
32 such returns in a safe or vault, and no person ~~[shall be]~~ *is*
33 permitted to handle, inspect or in any manner interfere with
34 such returns until canvassed by the Board of Councilmen.

35 2. The Board of Councilmen shall meet on the first
36 Tuesday after any election and canvass the returns and
37 declare the result. The election returns ~~[shall]~~ *must* then be
38 sealed and kept by the City Clerk for 6 months, and no person
39 shall have access thereto except on order of a court of
40 competent jurisdiction or by order of the Board of
41 Councilmen.

42 3. The City Clerk, under his hand and official seal, shall
43 issue to each person declared to be elected a certificate of
44 election. The officers so elected shall qualify and enter upon



1 the discharge of their respective duties on the ~~1st~~ *first*
2 Monday in :

3 (a) July next following their election ~~1st~~ *for those officers*
4 *elected in June 2007.*

5 (b) *January next following their election for those*
6 *officers elected in November 2008 and November of every*
7 *even-numbered year thereafter.*

8 4. If any election should result in a tie, the Board of
9 Councilmen shall summon the candidates who received the
10 tie vote and determine the tie by lot. The Clerk shall then
11 issue to the winner a certificate of election.

12 **Sec. 5.** Section 9.030 of the Charter of the City of Carlin,
13 being chapter 344, Statutes of Nevada 1971, at page 620, is hereby
14 repealed.

15 **Sec. 6.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval
16 and applies to the general election to be held on June 5, 2007.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

**Sec. 9.030 Designation of first Board of Councilmen,
Mayor under Charter; Office of Treasurer of unincorporated
town abolished.**

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law:

(a) The three Town Commissioners elected at the election held
in the incorporated Town of Carlin on May 4, 1971, pursuant to the
provisions of article VIII of the Charter of the unincorporated town
of Carlin adopted in 1925 shall hold office as Councilmen of the
City (or Mayor as hereinafter provided for) until the 1st Monday in
July 1975.

(b) The two Town Commissioners elected at the election held in
the incorporated Town of Carlin on the 1st Tuesday after the 1st
Monday in May 1969 (or their successors appointed pursuant to the
Charter of the unincorporated town) shall hold office as Councilmen
of the City until the 1st Monday in July 1973.

(c) A vacancy in the Board of Councilmen or in the office of
Mayor shall be filled as provided in section 1.060 of this Charter.

2. At the regular meeting of the Board of Councilmen held in
July 1971, the three Town Commissioners elected at the town
election held May 4, 1971, shall select one of their number, by lot or
otherwise, as Mayor of the City of Carlin. Thereafter such
Commissioner shall bear the title of Mayor and shall possess all the
powers and perform all the duties of Mayor provided for in this



Charter. His term of office as Mayor shall expire on the 1st Monday in July 1975.

3. The Office of Town Treasurer is abolished effective July 1, 1971.

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
