

SENATE BILL NO. 134—COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS

SUMMARY—Clarifies the provisions regarding the imposition of impact fees for certain capital improvements. (BDR 22-953)

AN ACT relating to impact fees; clarifying the provisions regarding the imposition of impact fees for certain capital improvements; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Under existing law, a local government may, by ordinance, impose an impact
2 fee for certain capital improvements. (NRS 278B.160) One such capital
3 improvement is a “police station project,” defined as a facility for a police station or
4 a police substation, or a facility designed for other uses directly related to the
5 provision of police services. (NRS 278B.020, 278B.087) This bill clarifies the
6 definition of “police station project” to include a jail or detention facility
7 appurtenant to a police station or a police substation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 278B.087 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 278B.087 **1.** “Police station project” means a facility for a
4 police station or a police substation.

5 **2.** *The term includes, without limitation, a jail or detention*
6 *facility appurtenant to a facility for a police station or a police*
7 *substation.*



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- 1 **3.** The term does not include:
2 ~~1-1~~ **(a)** A facility or portion of a facility that is designed for a
3 use related to the administration of a police department or any other
4 use not directly related to the provision of police services, including,
5 without limitation, the training of police officers; or
6 ~~1-2~~ **(b)** Any equipment, including, without limitation, vehicles,
7 used to provide police services.
8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
