SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing collection agencies.

AN ACT relating to collection agencies; removing an exemption related to licensing for certain foreign collection agencies; limiting the activities of certain foreign collection agencies; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law exempts certain persons from obtaining a collection agency
2 license in Nevada if certain conditions are met. (NRS 649.075) **Section 1** of this
3 bill removes that exemption and requires all such persons to either register as a
4 foreign collection agency or obtain a regular license.

5 **Section 2** of this bill removes the requirement that a person must hold a license
6 in another state in order to be registered as a foreign collection agency in Nevada.
7 (NRS 649.171)

8 Existing law states that a registered foreign collection agency must annually
9 submit proof that it will not solicit business in this State. (NRS 649.171) **Section 2**
10 of this bill adds the requirement that such an agency also must submit annually
11 proof that it will not respond to any bids, proposals or invitations for business in
12 this State. **Section 2** also limits the activities of such an agency to collecting from
13 residents of this State on behalf of residents of another state.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 649.075 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 649.075 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
3 person shall not conduct within this State a collection agency or
4 engage within this State in the business of collecting claims for
5 others, or of soliciting the right to collect or receive payment for
6 another of any claim, or advertise ~~H~~ or solicit, either in print, by
7 letter, in person or otherwise, the right to collect or receive payment
8 for another of any claim, or seek to make collection or obtain
9 payment of any claim on behalf of another without having first
10 applied for and obtained a license from the Commissioner.

11 2. ~~[A person is not required to obtain a license if:~~

12 ~~(a) The collection agency he works for is located outside of this
13 State;~~

14 ~~(b) His activities in this State are limited to the collection of
15 claims from residents of this State on behalf of residents of another
16 state; and~~

17 ~~(c) His contact with persons in this State is limited to interstate
18 communications by telephone, mail or facsimile.~~

19 ~~3.]~~ A person is not required to obtain a license if the person
20 holds a certificate of registration as a foreign collection agency
21 issued by the Commissioner pursuant to NRS 649.171.

22 **Sec. 2.** NRS 649.171 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 649.171 1. A person who is not licensed in this State as a
24 collection agency may apply to the Commissioner for a certificate of
25 registration as a foreign collection agency.

26 2. To be issued and to hold a certificate of registration as a
27 foreign collection agency, a person:

28 (a) ~~[Must hold a license or permit to do business as a collection
29 agency in another state;~~

30 ~~(b)~~ Must meet the qualifications to do business as a collection
31 agency in this State;

32 ~~(c)~~ Must not have any employees or agents present in this
33 State who engage in the collection of claims and must not maintain
34 any business locations in this State as a collection agency;

35 ~~(d)~~ (c) Must submit proof to the Commissioner, upon
36 application and upon each annual renewal of the ~~certificate~~
37 *certificate* of registration, that the person and his employees and
38 agents will not, in this State:

39 (1) Engage in the business of soliciting the right to collect or
40 receive payment for another of any claim; ~~for~~

41 (2) *Respond to a bid, proposal or invitation for the right to
42 collect or receive payment for another of any claim; or*

1 (3) Advertise or solicit, either in print, by letter, in person or
2 otherwise, the right to collect or receive payment for another of any
3 claim;

4 ~~(e)~~ (d) When collecting claims against debtors who are
5 present in this State, must:

6 (1) Limit his activities and those of his employees and agents
7 to interstate communications by telephone, mail or facsimile; ~~and~~

8 (2) *Limit his activities and those of his employees and
9 agents to the collection of claims from residents of this State on
10 behalf of residents of another state; and*

11 (3) Comply with the requirements of NRS 649.305 to
12 649.375, inclusive, with regard to his activities and those of his
13 employees and agents;

14 ~~(e)~~ (e) Must pay:

15 (1) A fee to apply for a certificate of registration of not less
16 than \$200 and not more than \$600, prorated on the basis of the
17 registration year as determined by the Commissioner; and

18 (2) An annual renewal fee of not more than \$200;

19 ~~(f)~~ (f) Must deposit and maintain a bond or an appropriate
20 substitute for the bond in the same manner as an applicant or
21 licensee pursuant to NRS 649.105, 649.115 and 649.119;

22 ~~(g)~~ (g) Must maintain his accounts, books and records in
23 accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and in
24 accordance with the requirements of subsection 1 of NRS 649.335;
25 and

26 ~~(h)~~ (h) Must pay any fees related to any examination of his
27 accounts, books and records conducted by the Commissioner
28 pursuant to subsection 3.

29 3. The Commissioner may conduct an annual examination and
30 any additional examinations pursuant to NRS 649.335 of the
31 accounts, books and records of each person who holds a certificate
32 of registration as a foreign collection agency.

33 4. The Commissioner may take disciplinary action pursuant to
34 NRS 649.385, 649.390 and 649.395 against a person who holds a
35 certificate of registration as a foreign collection agency for any act
36 or omission that would be grounds for taking such disciplinary
37 action under those sections.

38 5. The Commissioner shall adopt:

39 (a) Regulations establishing the amount of the fees required
40 pursuant to this section; and

41 (b) Any other regulations as may be necessary to carry out the
42 provisions of this section.

43 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
