AN ACT making an appropriation to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, for special programs and fellowships sponsored by the Black Mountain Institute; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, for special  
3 programs and fellowships sponsored by the Black Mountain  
4 Institute:

5              For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$100,000

6              For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$100,000

7       **Sec. 2.** The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are  
8 available for either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums  
9 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the  
10 entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which  
11 money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in  
12 any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining  
13 must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by  
14 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity

1 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and  
2 must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
3 September 18, 2009.

4       **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
