

SENATE BILL NO. 190—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the State Public Works Board to design housing units at institutions within the Department of Corrections. (BDR S-1219)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Public Works Board to design housing units at institutions within the Department of Corrections; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the State Public Works Board the sum of \$826,597 to design four housing units to accommodate inmate population growth at institutions within the Department of Corrections.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2007, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 21, 2007, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 21, 2007.

1 **Sec. 3.** The State Public Works Board is authorized to use the
2 Design-Build delivery method for this project.

3 **Sec. 4.** The project enumerated in this act is exempt from the
4 competitive bidding requirements of chapters 333 and 338 of NRS,
5 the Green Building Standards adopted pursuant to NRS 701.217, the
6 administrative regulations concerning consultant selection
7 procedures and the provisions of NRS 338.1711 to 338.1727,
8 inclusive, governing contracts involving design-build teams.

9 **Sec. 5.** Except as otherwise specified in this act, the State
10 Public Works Board shall carry out the provisions of this act as
11 provided in chapter 341 of NRS. The Board shall ensure that
12 qualified persons are employed to accomplish the authorized work.
13 Every contract pertaining to the work must be approved by the
14 Attorney General.

15 **Sec. 6.** All state agencies involved in the design and
16 construction of the projects enumerated in this act shall cooperate
17 with the State Public Works Board to expedite the completion of the
18 project.

19 **Sec. 7.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
