

SENATE BILL NO. 195—COMMITTEE ON
HUMAN RESOURCES AND EDUCATION

(ON BEHALF OF DOUGLAS COUNTY)

SUMMARY—Enacts provisions governing the operation and use of a recreation area. (BDR 40-492)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: Increases or Newly Provides for Term of Imprisonment in County or City Jail or Detention Facility.

EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [~~omitted material~~] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to recreation areas; prohibiting a person who uses a recreation area from engaging in certain conduct; requiring such a person to follow certain safety requirements; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law sets forth prohibitions, penalties and duties for a person who
2 operates or uses a skateboard park, amusement park or snow recreation area.
3 (Chapters 455A and 455B of NRS) Generally those laws prohibit a person from
4 engaging in certain activities at the park or snow recreation area, prescribe duties
5 for the owner, operator or user of the park or area and specifically state that a
6 county, city or unincorporated town may adopt additional ordinances governing the
7 park or area as long as the ordinances do not conflict with existing statutes.
8 (Chapters 455A and 455B of NRS)

9 This bill enacts similar prohibitions, penalties and duties for a person who
10 operates or uses a recreation area. **Section 4** of this bill defines “recreation area” as
11 a trailhead or water access area. **Section 8** of this bill prohibits certain conduct by a
12 person using a recreation area. **Section 9** of this bill imposes certain duties on a
13 person using a recreation area, such as a duty to locate and ascertain the meaning of
14 any sign that is posted by the operator of the recreation area. **Section 10** of this bill
15 absolves the operator of a recreation area and an owner of private property from
16 liability for the death or injury of a person or for damage to property caused or
17 sustained by a person using the recreation area if the person knowingly enters an
18 area which is outside the recreation area. **Section 10** also requires an operator to

19 provide certain information about the recreation area at trailheads and water access
20 areas. **Section 11** of this bill prohibits a person from entering or using a recreation
21 area while intoxicated or under the influence of a controlled substance. **Section 12**
22 of this bill imposes a misdemeanor penalty against a person who fails to comply
23 with certain reporting requirements occurring upon the person's involvement in a
24 collision or an accident with another person. **Section 14** of this bill clarifies that the
25 intent of the bill is not to preempt a county, city or unincorporated town from
26 adopting additional ordinances which are consistent with this bill. **Section 14** also
27 specifies that the provisions of the bill are in addition to certain statutory and
28 regulatory provisions relating to state parks and state recreational areas.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 455B of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 14, inclusive, of this
3 act.

4 **Sec. 2.** *As used in sections 2 to 14, inclusive, of this act,
5 unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined
6 in sections 3 to 7, inclusive, of this act have the meanings ascribed
7 to them in those sections.*

8 **Sec. 3.** *"Operator" means a government, governmental
9 agency or political subdivision of a government that owns,
10 controls, operates or manages a recreation area.*

11 **Sec. 4.** *"Recreation area" means a trailhead or water access
12 area. The term does not include:*

- 13 **1. A snow recreation area as defined in NRS 455A.083; or**
- 14 **2. A skateboard park as defined in NRS 455B.240.**

15 **Sec. 5.** (Deleted by amendment.)

16 **Sec. 6.** *"Trailhead" means the beginning point of a trail,
17 including, without limitation, any facility for parking, water or
18 sanitation that is available for use at that point.*

19 **Sec. 7.** *"Water access area" includes, without limitation, a
20 beach, river entry or exit point and land located at or below the
21 ordinary high water mark of a navigable body of water within this
22 State.*

23 **Sec. 8. A person shall not:**

- 24 **1. Fail or refuse to comply with:**

25 **(a) Reasonable instructions provided by an operator or an
26 authorized agent or employee of an operator regarding the use of
27 a recreation area; or**

28 **(b) Rules concerning safety that are posted on a sign in a
29 conspicuous place by an operator;**

30 **2. Intentionally place, drop or throw any object in the path of
31 a user of a recreation area;**

1 3. *Conduct himself in a manner that interferes with the safe
2 operation of a recreation area or with the safety of other users of a
3 recreation area; or*

4 4. *Trespass on any private property located in or adjacent to a
5 recreation area.*

6 Sec. 9. 1. *A person using a recreation area shall, to the
7 extent possible:*

8 (a) *Locate and ascertain:*

9 (1) *The meaning of any sign that is posted in or near the
10 recreation area by the operator of the recreation area; and*

11 (2) *The boundaries of all private property adjoining the
12 recreation area;*

13 (b) *Heed warnings and other information posted by the
14 operator of the recreation area;*

15 (c) *Conduct himself in such a manner as to avoid injury to
16 persons and damage to property in the recreation area;*

17 (d) *Familiarize himself with the natural conditions of the
18 recreation area and any resulting dangerous conditions in the
19 recreation area and any private property located in or adjacent to
20 the recreation area; and*

21 (e) *Familiarize himself with any dangerous conditions relating
22 to an irrigation system in or near the recreation area.*

23 2. *A person using a recreation area shall not tamper with or
24 alter an irrigation system or any part of an irrigation system in the
25 recreation area.*

26 Sec. 10. 1. *A person who enters a recreation area
27 unlawfully shall be deemed to be a trespasser.*

28 2. *A person who sustains a personal injury while he is using
29 a recreation area shall notify the operator or an authorized agent
30 or employee of the operator of the injury as soon as reasonably
31 possible.*

32 3. *Except as otherwise provided by law, an operator or an
33 owner of private property is not liable for the death or injury of a
34 person or for damage to property caused or sustained by a person
35 using a recreation area if the person knowingly enters an area
36 which is located outside the recreation area.*

37 4. *An operator shall take reasonable steps to minimize known
38 dangers and conditions of trailheads and water access areas
39 within his control.*

40 5. *An operator shall post signs in conspicuous places or
41 provide other information at trailheads and water access areas
42 that:*

43 (a) *Identify the boundaries of the recreation area and
44 immediately adjacent private property;*

45 (b) *Prescribe rules concerning safety, conduct and use; and*

1 (c) Provide warnings about known dangerous conditions and
2 potential hazards.

3 Sec. 11. 1. A person shall not enter or use a recreation area
4 while intoxicated or under the influence of a controlled substance,
5 unless in accordance with:

6 (a) A prescription lawfully issued to the person; or

7 (b) The provisions of chapter 453A of NRS.

8 2. An operator or an authorized agent or employee of an
9 operator may prohibit a person from entering or using a
10 recreation area if he reasonably believes that the person is under
11 the influence of alcohol, prescription drugs or a controlled
12 substance. An operator or an authorized agent or employee of an
13 operator is not civilly or criminally liable for prohibiting a person
14 from entering or using a recreation area pursuant to this
15 subsection.

16 Sec. 12. 1. A person using a recreation area who is
17 involved in a collision or an accident in which another person is
18 injured shall provide his name and current address to the injured
19 person and the operator or an authorized agent or employee of the
20 operator:

21 (a) Before he leaves the vicinity of the collision or accident; or

22 (b) As soon as reasonably possible after leaving the vicinity of
23 the collision or accident to secure aid for the injured person.

24 2. A person who violates a provision of this section is guilty of
25 a misdemeanor.

26 Sec. 13. An operator may revoke the license or privilege of a
27 person to use a recreation area if the person violates any provision
28 of sections 2 to 14, inclusive, of this act.

29 Sec. 14. The provisions of sections 2 to 14, inclusive, of this
30 act:

31 1. Do not prohibit a county, city or unincorporated town from
32 adopting ordinances that regulate a recreation area which are
33 consistent with the provisions of sections 2 to 14, inclusive, of this
34 act.

35 2. Are in addition to any provision of chapter 407 of NRS or
36 any regulation adopted pursuant to that chapter that is applicable
37 to a recreation area.

38 Sec. 15. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
