

SENATE BILL NO. 205—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

MARCH 5, 2007

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Inc., to supplement costs associated with the distribution of food from the Commodity Supplemental Food Program in northern Nevada. (BDR S-756)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Inc., to supplement costs associated with the distribution of food from the Commodity Supplemental Food Program in northern Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Inc., the sum of \$100,000 to supplement costs associated with the distribution of food from the Commodity Supplemental Food Program in northern Nevada.

2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1, the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Inc., shall:

(a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Inc., through December 1, 2008; and

(b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports,



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1 vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise,
2 of the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Inc., regardless of their form
3 or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct
4 an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
5 subsection 1.

6 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
7 subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
8 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity
9 to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise
10 transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
11 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
12 September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was
13 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
14 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
15 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

16 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
