

SENATE BILL NO. 219—COMMITTEE ON  
HUMAN RESOURCES AND EDUCATION

(ON BEHALF OF THE OFFICE OF VETERANS' SERVICES)

MARCH 6, 2007

**SUMMARY**—Creates the Gift Account for Veterans in the State General Fund and authorizes the use of money in the Account for the support of outreach programs and services for veterans and their families. (BDR 37-637)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [~~omitted material~~] is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to veterans; creating the Gift Account for Veterans in the State General Fund; requiring that the additional fees collected by the Department of Motor Vehicles for the issuance or renewal of special license plates for the support of outreach programs and services for veterans and their families be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the Account; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      **Section 1** of this bill creates the Gift Account for Veterans in the State General  
2      Fund and authorizes money deposited in the Account to be used only for the  
3      support of outreach programs and services for veterans and their families. **Section 2**  
4      of this bill changes the purpose for the issuance of the special plates from the  
5      support for veterans' homes to the support of outreach programs and services for  
6      veterans and their families. **Section 3** of this bill requires that all additional fees  
7      collected by the Department of Motor Vehicles for the issuance or renewal of  
8      special license plates for the support of outreach programs and services for veterans  
9      and their families must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the Gift  
10     Account for Veterans.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 417.145 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2        417.145 1. The Veterans' Home Account is hereby  
3 established in the State General Fund.

4        2. Money received from:

5           (a) Payments made by the United States Department of Veterans  
6 Affairs for veterans who receive care in a veterans' home;  
7           (b) Other payments for medical care and services;  
8           (c) Appropriations made by the Legislature for veterans' homes;  
9           (d) Federal grants and other money received pursuant to  
10 paragraph (c) of subsection 1 of NRS 417.147;

11          (e) Money collected pursuant to the schedule of rates established  
12 pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 417.147 for occupancy of rooms at  
13 veterans' homes; and

14          (f) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7, gifts of money  
15 and proceeds derived from the sale of gifts of personal property for  
16 the use of veterans' homes, if the use of **[such] those** gifts has not  
17 been restricted by the donor,

18          → must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the  
19 Veterans' Home Account.

20          3. Interest and income must not be computed on the money in  
21 the Veterans' Home Account.

22          4. The Veterans' Home Account must be administered by the  
23 Executive Director, with the advice of the administrators, and except  
24 as otherwise provided in paragraph (c) of subsection 1 of NRS  
25 417.147, the money deposited in the Veterans' Home Account may  
26 only be expended for:

27           (a) The establishment, management, maintenance and operation  
28 of veterans' homes;

29           (b) A program or service related to a veterans' home;  
30           (c) The solicitation of other sources of money to fund a  
31 veterans' home; and

32           (d) The purpose of informing the public about issues concerning  
33 the establishment and uses of a veterans' home.

34          5. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7, gifts of  
35 personal property for the use of veterans' homes:

36           (a) May be sold or exchanged if the sale or exchange is  
37 approved by the State Board of Examiners; or

38           (b) May be used in kind if the gifts are not appropriate for  
39 conversion to money.

40          6. All money in the Veterans' Home Account must be paid out  
41 on claims approved by the Executive Director as other claims  
42 against the State are paid.



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1       7. The Gift Account for Veterans' Homes is hereby established  
2 in the State General Fund. Gifts of money or personal property  
3 which the donor has restricted to one or more uses at a veterans'  
4 home must be used only in the manner designated by the donor.  
5 Gifts of money which the donor has restricted to one or more uses at  
6 a veterans' home must be deposited with the State Treasurer for  
7 credit to the Gift Account for Veterans' Homes. The interest and  
8 income earned on the money in the Gift Account for Veterans'  
9 Homes, after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to  
10 the Gift Account for Veterans' Homes. Any money remaining in the  
11 Gift Account for Veterans' Homes at the end of each fiscal year  
12 does not lapse to the State General Fund, but must be carried  
13 forward into the next fiscal year.

14      8. *The Gift Account for Veterans is hereby created in the  
15 State General Fund. The Executive Director shall administer the  
16 Gift Account for Veterans. The money deposited in the Gift  
17 Account for Veterans pursuant to NRS 482.3764 may only be used  
18 for the support of outreach programs and services for veterans  
19 and their families. The interest and income earned on the money  
20 in the Gift Account for Veterans, after deducting any applicable  
21 charges, must be credited to the Gift Account for Veterans. All  
22 money in the Gift Account for Veterans must be paid out on  
23 claims approved by the Executive Director as other claims against  
24 the State are paid. Any money remaining in the Gift Account for  
25 Veterans at the end of each fiscal year does not lapse to the State  
26 General Fund, but must be carried forward into the next fiscal  
27 year.*

28      9. The Executive Director shall, on or before August 1 of each  
29 year, prepare and submit to the Interim Finance Committee a report  
30 detailing the expenditures made from the Gift Account for Veterans'  
31 Homes ~~[that are attributable to the money deposited in that account  
32 pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 482.3764.] and the Gift Account  
for Veterans.~~

33      Sec. 2. NRS 482.3763 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
34      482.3763 1. The Director shall order the preparation of  
35 special license plates ~~for the~~ support of ~~veterans' homes,~~  
36 *outreach programs and services for veterans and their families*  
37 and establish procedures for the application for and issuance of the  
38 plates.

39      2. The Department shall, upon application therefor and  
40 payment of the prescribed fees, issue special license plates ~~for~~ support of  
41 ~~veterans' homes~~ *outreach programs and services  
42 for veterans and their families* to:



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1       (a) A veteran of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps or  
2 Coast Guard of the United States, a reserve component thereof or  
3 the National Guard; or

4       (b) The spouse, parent or child of a person described in  
5 paragraph (a).

6       → The plates must be inscribed with the word "VETERAN" and  
7 with the seal of the branch of the Armed Forces of the United States  
8 or the seal of the National Guard, as applicable, requested by the  
9 applicant. A person may request that personalized prestige license  
10 plates issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 be combined with special  
11 license plates ~~[in]~~ for the support of ~~veterans' homes~~ outreach  
12 programs and services for veterans and their families if that person  
13 pays the fees for the personalized prestige license plates in addition  
14 to the fees for the special license plates ~~[in]~~ for the support of  
15 ~~veterans' homes~~ outreach programs and services for veterans  
16 and their families pursuant to subsection 4.

17      3. If, during a registration year, the holder of special plates  
18 issued pursuant to this section disposes of the vehicle to which the  
19 plates are affixed, the holder shall:

20       (a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle which  
21 meets the requirements of this section if the holder pays the fee for  
22 the transfer of the registration and any registration fee or  
23 governmental services tax due pursuant to NRS 482.399; or

24       (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,  
25 return them to the Department.

26      4. In addition to all other applicable registration and license  
27 fees and governmental services taxes, and to the special fee ~~[for~~  
28 ~~veterans' homes.] imposed pursuant to NRS 482.3764 for the~~  
29 ~~support of outreach programs and services for veterans and their~~  
30 ~~families,~~ the fee for:

- 31       (a) The initial issuance of the special license plates is \$35.  
32       (b) The annual renewal sticker is \$10.

33      5. If the special plates issued pursuant to this section are lost,  
34 stolen or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle may secure a set of  
35 replacement license plates from the Department for a fee of \$10.

36      **Sec. 3.** NRS 482.3764 is hereby amended to read as follows:

37      482.3764 1. Before the Department issues to any person,  
38 pursuant to NRS 482.3763:

- 39       (a) An initial set of special license plates, it shall:  
40           (1) Collect a special fee for ~~[a veterans' home]~~ the support of  
41 outreach programs and services for veterans and their families in  
42 the amount of \$25; and

43           (2) Affix a decal to each plate if requested by an applicant  
44 who meets the requirements set forth in NRS 482.37635.

- 45       (b) An annual renewal sticker, it shall:



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1           (1) Collect a special fee for ~~a veterans' home~~ **the support of outreach programs and services for veterans and their families** in  
2           the amount of \$20; and

4           (2) Affix a decal to each plate if requested by an applicant  
5           who meets the requirements set forth in NRS 482.37635.

6           2. The Department shall deposit ~~the first \$100,000~~ **all money**  
7           collected pursuant to this section ~~each year~~ with the State  
8           Treasurer for credit to the Gift Account for ~~Veterans' Homes,~~  
9           **established] Veterans created** by subsection ~~F~~ 8 of NRS 417.145.  
10          ~~[Thereafter, any additional amount collected pursuant to this section  
11          during the year must be deposited in the State General Fund.]~~

12          **Sec. 4.** The State Controller shall, as soon as practicable on or  
13          after October 1, 2007, transfer to the Gift Account for Veterans  
14          created by NRS 417.145, as amended by section 1 of this act, all  
15          money in the Gift Account for Veterans' Homes that was collected  
16          by the Department of Motor Vehicles for the issuance or renewal of  
17          special license plates in support of veterans' homes and deposited in  
18          the Gift Account for Veterans' Homes pursuant to NRS 482.3764.

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
