AN ACT relating to chiropractic; increasing the maximum amount
of the fee that the Chiropractic Physicians’ Board of
Nevada may charge for its review of certain courses;
establishing the maximum amount of the fees that the
Board may charge for providing written verification that a
person is licensed to practice chiropractic and for the
Board’s annual review of certain chiropractic schools or
colleges; and providing other matters properly relating
thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill increases the maximum amount of the fee that the Chiropractic
2 Physicians’ Board of Nevada may charge for its review of a course offered by a
3 chiropractic school or college or a course of continuing education in chiropractic.
4 (NRS 634.135) This bill also establishes the maximum amount of the fees that the
5 Board may charge for providing written verification that a person is licensed to
6 practice chiropractic and for the Board’s annual review of a chiropractic school or
7 college which is not accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education, a
8 professional association or a commercial entity and which offers a course of
9 continuing education in chiropractic.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 634.135 is hereby amended to read as follows:
634.135 1. The Board may charge and collect fees not to
exceed:

For the restoration to active status of an inactive license to practice chiropractic.....	300.00
For reinstating a license to practice chiropractic which has been suspended or revoked	500.00
For reinstating a certificate as a chiropractor's assistant which has been suspended pursuant to NRS 634.130.....	100.00
For a review of any subject on the examination	25.00
For the issuance of a duplicate license or for changing the name on a license	35.00
For written certification of licensure <i>the issuance of a certificate of good standing for a person licensed to practice chiropractic</i>	25.00
<i>For providing written verification that a person is licensed to practice chiropractic</i>	<i>50.00</i>
For providing a list of persons who are licensed to practice chiropractic to a person who is not licensed to practice chiropractic.....	25.00
For providing a list of persons who were licensed to practice chiropractic following the most recent examination of the Board to a person who is not licensed to practice chiropractic.....	10.00

23 2. In addition to the fees set forth in subsection 1, the Board
24 may charge and collect reasonable and necessary fees for any other
25 service it provides.

26 3. For a check or other method of payment made payable to the
27 Board or tendered to the Board that is returned to the Board or
28 otherwise dishonored upon presentation for payment, the Board
29 shall assess and collect a fee in the amount established by the State
30 Controller pursuant to NRS 353C.115.
