
SENATE BILL No. 251—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the Division of Water Resources, Division of Forestry, Forestry Conservation Camps and Division of State Parks. (BDR S-1221)

AN ACT making appropriations to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for replacement vehicles and computer hardware and software and to restore the balance in the Channel Clearance Account; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the:

3 1. Division of Water Resources of the State Department of
4 Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$333,164 for
5 replacement trucks and computer hardware, and to restore the
6 balance in the Channel Clearance Account.

7 2. Division of Forestry of the Department the sum of \$919,517
8 for the replacement of computer hardware and software and 22
9 vehicles that are old or in poor condition.

10 3. Department for Forestry Conservation Camps the sum of
11 \$750,574 for the replacement of computer hardware and software,
12 and to purchase new pick-up trucks and mechanic service trucks.



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1 4. Division of State Parks of the Department the sum of
2 \$1,754,464 for the replacement of AutoCAD stations, personal
3 computers and software, and 61 vehicles that are inoperable or in
4 poor condition, and the purchase of Geographic Information System
5 software.

6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
8 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriations are made or
9 any entity to which money from the appropriations is granted or
10 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
11 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
12 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
13 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
14 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
15 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

16 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
