

## SENATE BILL NO. 252—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

**SUMMARY**—Makes appropriations to the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services of the Department of Health and Human Services for the replacement of certain office equipment and computers. (BDR S-1217)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services of the Department of Health and Human Services for the replacement of certain office equipment and computers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services, Administration, of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of \$380,406 for routine replacement of aging equipment and computers.

2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services for Welfare Field Services the sum of \$900,865 for replacement of aging computers, software and telephones.

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriations are made or any entity to which money from the appropriations is granted or

1 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
2 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
3 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money  
4 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
5 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
6 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
