

SENATE BILL NO. 254—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Clark County Public Education Foundation and the Washoe County School District Educational Foundation for new programs and outreach expansion. (BDR S-1229)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Clark County Public Education Foundation and the Washoe County School District Educational Foundation for new programs and outreach expansion; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the:

1. Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc., the sum of \$250,000 for new programs and expansion of outreach efforts.

2. Washoe County School District Educational Foundation, Inc., the sum of \$150,000 for new programs and expansion of outreach efforts.

Sec. 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by section 1 of this act, the Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc., and the Washoe County School District Educational Foundation, Inc., respectively, shall each:

1. Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each



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1 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this
2 act from the date on which the money was received by the Clark
3 County Public Education Foundation, Inc., and the Washoe County
4 School District Educational Foundation, Inc., respectively, through
5 December 1, 2008; and

6 2. Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
7 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that decreases each
8 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this
9 act from the date on which the money was received by the
10 foundation through June 30, 2009; and

11 3. Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
12 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
13 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
14 otherwise, of the Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc.,
15 and the Washoe County School District Educational Foundation,
16 Inc., respectively, regardless of their form or location, that the
17 Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use
18 of the money appropriated pursuant to section 1 of this act.

19 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
20 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
21 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
22 any entity to which the money from the appropriation is granted or
23 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
24 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
25 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
26 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
27 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
28 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

29 **Sec. 4.** The appropriations made by the provisions of this act
30 are not intended to finance ongoing expenditures and the
31 expenditures financed with those appropriations must not be
32 included as base budget expenditures when developing the budget
33 for consideration by the 2009 Legislature.

34 **Sec. 5.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
