
SENATE BILL NO. 255—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

MARCH 12, 2007

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to High Sierra Industries, Inc., for facilities to support, train and employ persons with disabilities. (BDR S-767)

AN ACT making an appropriation to High Sierra Industries, Inc., for facilities to support, train and employ persons with disabilities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to High Sierra Industries, Inc., the sum of \$5,000,000
3 for facilities to support, train and employ persons with disabilities.

4 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
5 High Sierra Industries, Inc., shall:

6 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
7 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each
8 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
9 from the date on which the money was received by High Sierra
10 Industries, Inc., through December 1, 2008; and

11 (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
12 to the Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports,
13 vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise,
14 of High Sierra Industries, Inc., regardless of their form or location,
15 that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of
16 the use of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

1 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
2 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
3 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
4 any entity to which the money from the appropriation is granted or
5 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
6 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
7 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
8 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
9 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
10 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

11 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
