
SENATE BILL No. 290—SENATOR MATHEWS**MARCH 15, 2007**

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Department of Education for the support of public broadcasting.
(BDR S-448)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Education for the support of public broadcasting; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$600,000
3 for the support of nonprofit public broadcasting stations in Nevada
4 whose programs are devoted primarily to serving the educational,
5 informational and cultural needs of Nevada.

6 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
7 each nonprofit public broadcasting station shall:

8 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
11 from the date on which the money was received by each nonprofit
12 public broadcasting station through December 1, 2008;

13 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
14 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each
15 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
16 from the date on which the money was received by each nonprofit
17 public broadcasting station through June 30, 2009; and



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1 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
2 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
3 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
4 otherwise, of each nonprofit public broadcasting station, regardless
5 of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems
6 necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated
7 pursuant to subsection 1.

8 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
9 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
10 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
11 any entity to which the money from the appropriation is granted or
12 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
13 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
14 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
15 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
16 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
17 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

18 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.

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
