**SUMMARY**—Authorizes the establishment of measures of performance for certain state agencies. (BDR 18-55)

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AN ACT relating to the State Controller; authorizing the establishment of measures of performance for certain state agencies to evaluate the performance and efficient use of public resources by those agencies; authorizing certain annual reporting concerning the measures of performance; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1        This bill authorizes the State Controller, in consultation with a state agency, to  
2 establish measures of performance that may be used to evaluate the performance of  
3 the agency and the efficiency of its use of public resources. This bill also authorizes  
4 the State Controller to report annually to the Governor and the Legislature  
5 concerning the measures of performance established during the immediately  
6 preceding fiscal year.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        **Section 1.** Chapter 227 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3        ***1. The State Controller may, in consultation with a state  
4 agency, establish relevant, objective and effective measures of***

1      *performance for the agency pursuant to which its performance*  
2      *and efficient use of public resources may be evaluated.*

3      *2. The State Controller may prepare an annual written report*  
4      *which indicates for each state agency with which he consults*  
5      *pursuant to subsection 1 during the immediately preceding fiscal*  
6      *year the established measures of performance and which may*  
7      *include any other information that the State Controller determines*  
8      *is relevant. The State Controller may, on or before February 1 of*  
9      *each year, submit the report:*

10     *(a) To the Governor; and*

11     *(b) To the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for*  
12     *transmittal:*

13     *(1) During an odd-numbered year, to the Legislature.*

14     *(2) During an even-numbered year, to the Interim Finance*  
15     *Committee.*

16     *3. As used in this section, "state agency" means, except the*  
17     *boards set forth in NRS 353.005, each department, institution and*  
18     *agency in the Executive Department of the State Government.*

19     Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
