SUMMARY—Clarifies the purposes for which money in the Fort Mohave Valley Development Account may be used. (BDR 26-1317)

AN ACT relating to public lands; clarifying the purposes for which money in the Fort Mohave Valley Development Account may be used; making an appropriation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, the Colorado River Commission of Nevada has various powers and duties relating to the development of the Fort Mojave Valley, including the authority to expend money from the Fort Mohave Valley Development Account for specified purposes. (NRS 321.480-321.536) **Section 1** of this bill clarifies that the Commission may expend money in the Account only to carry out the Fort Mohave Valley Development Law. **Section 2** of this bill appropriates \$5 million from the State General Fund to the Account.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 321.536 is hereby amended to read as follows:
321.536 1. The Commission may use money in the Fort Mohave Valley Development Account to purchase or otherwise acquire lands described in NRS 321.500 and 321.534 in an amount not to exceed \$3,200,000.

1 2. After the allocation of money pursuant to subsection 1, the
2 Commission may use money in the Fort Mohave Development
3 Account to administer the provisions of NRS 321.480 to 321.536,
4 inclusive. ~~, and any other expenditures authorized by law.~~

5 3. After the allocation of money pursuant to subsections 1 and
6 2, the Commission, with the concurrence of the Board of County
7 Commissioners of Clark County, shall, pursuant to NRS 353.150 to
8 353.246, inclusive, prepare and submit a program for the use of the
9 remaining money available in the Fort Mohave Valley Development
10 Account to develop state and local capital improvements. The
11 program may include the planning, design and construction of those
12 improvements which develop the land in the Fort Mohave Valley or
13 in the service area of any general improvement district, special
14 district, town or city which contains all or a part of the land in the
15 Fort Mohave Valley, or both. If the program is approved, the
16 Commission shall approve proper claims against the Account made
17 in conformance with the program in a manner which ensures that
18 any claims concerning a particular capital improvement are
19 approved and paid before any claims concerning another capital
20 improvement are approved and paid.

21 4. After disposition of the money in the Fort Mohave Valley
22 Development Account pursuant to subsections 1, 2 and 3, the
23 Commission may use any remaining money to:

24 (a) Develop and dispose of any land described in NRS 321.534
25 acquired by the Commission;

26 (b) Purchase or otherwise acquire, develop and dispose of any
27 other land which the Commission is authorized to purchase, acquire,
28 develop or dispose of; and

29 (c) Perform any other acts authorized by the Legislative
30 Commission.

31 5. Any money:

32 (a) Received from the development or disposition of the land
33 described in NRS 321.534; or

34 (b) Received from the development or disposition of any other
35 land which the Commission acquires using money from the Fort
36 Mohave Valley Development Account pursuant to paragraph (b) of
37 subsection 4,

38 must be deposited in the Fort Mohave Valley Development
39 Account.

40 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
41 Fund to the Fort Mohave Valley Development Account created by
42 NRS 321.520 the sum of \$5,000,000 to replenish the Account.

43 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
