SENATE BILL NO. 335—SENATOR RHOADS

**SUMMARY**—Enacts provisions to assist the Department of Health and Human Services with the recruitment and retention of staff in rural Nevada. (BDR 23-1308)

AN ACT relating to the Department of Health and Human Services; authorizing the divisions of the Department to purchase retirement credits for certain employees; making an appropriation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      **Section 1** of this bill authorizes the divisions of the Department of Health and  
2      Human Services to purchase retirement service credits for certain employees who  
3      are employed by a division of the Department in areas of the State in which the  
4      Director of the Department has determined there is difficulty attracting, recruiting  
5      and retaining capable persons to work as licensed social workers, licensed clinical  
6      social workers, licensed registered nurses, licensed psychologists, licensed  
7      therapists, licensed counselors or in any other position within the Department for  
8      which a professional license is required and that is designated by the Director as  
9      eligible to receive retirement credits purchased by a division.

10     **Section 3** of this bill makes an appropriation to the Department in the amount  
11    of \$3.5 million to pay for the purchase of the retirement service credits authorized  
12    by **section 1** of this bill.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 286 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      *1. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 3 and 4 and  
4 except as otherwise required as a result of NRS 286.537, any  
5 division of the Department may pay the cost for an employee to  
6 purchase one-fifth of a year of service pursuant to subsection 2 of  
7 NRS 286.300 if:*

8      *(a) The employee is a member of the System and has at least 5  
9 years of service;*

10     *(b) The employee has been employed in his position for at least  
11 5 consecutive years, regardless of whether the employment was  
12 with one or more divisions; and*

13     *(c) Each evaluation of the employee conducted pursuant to  
14 NRS 284.340 is at least satisfactory for the years of employment  
15 required by paragraph (b).*

16     *2. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 3 and 4, the  
17 division shall pay the cost for an employee to purchase one-fifth of  
18 a year of service for each year that the employee satisfies the  
19 requirements of subsection 1.*

20     *3. In no event may the years of service purchased by an  
21 employee as a result of subsection 2 of NRS 286.300 exceed 5  
22 years.*

23     *4. In paying the cost for an employee to purchase service  
24 pursuant to this section, a division shall pay the cost of 1 year of  
25 service for each 5-year period of creditable employment, and shall  
26 not pay for fractional years of service.*

27     *5. As used in this section:*

28     *(a) "Department" means the Department of Health and  
29 Human Services.*

30     *(b) "Director" means the Director of the Department.*

31     *(c) "Division" means a division of the Department established  
32 pursuant to NRS 232.300.*

33     *(d) "Employee" means a person who:*

34     *(1) Is employed by a division as a licensed social worker,  
35 licensed clinical social worker, licensed registered nurse, licensed  
36 psychologist, licensed therapist, licensed counselor or in any other  
37 position within the Department for which a professional license is  
38 required and who is designated by the Director as eligible to  
39 receive retirement credits purchased by a division pursuant to this  
40 section; and*

41     *(2) Is employed by a division in an area of the State in  
42 which the Director determines that the division has experienced*

1      ***difficulty in attracting, recruiting and retaining capable persons to***  
2      ***serve in the positions described in subparagraph (I).***

3      **Sec. 2.** NRS 286.3005 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4      286.3005 A state agency may purchase credit for service on  
5      behalf of a member only as provided in NRS 286.3007 ~~H and~~  
6      ***section 1 of this act.*** Except as otherwise required as a result of  
7      NRS 286.537 or 391.165, any other public employer may pay any  
8      portion of the cost to purchase credit for service under NRS  
9      286.300, but is not required to do so. No credit may be validated  
10     unless the cost of purchasing credit has been paid.

11     **Sec. 3.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
12     General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the  
13     sum of \$3,500,000 to pay for the purchase of retirement credits for  
14     certain employees as set forth in section 1 of this act.

15     2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
16     subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,  
17     2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity  
18     to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise  
19     transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated  
20     money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after  
21     September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was  
22     appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
23     granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
24     Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

25     **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
