AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Aging Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services for relocation expenses; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Aging Services Division of the Department of
- 3 Health and Human Services the sum of \$39,613 to cover relocation
- 4 expenses due to an expired lease. This appropriation is supplemental
- 5 to that made by section 20 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005,
- 6 at page 1939.
- 7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
