

SENATE BILL NO. 33—COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

**SUMMARY**—Makes an appropriation to the Division of Parole and Probation of the Department of Public Safety for the acquisition and installation of electronic devices to access gated communities. (BDR S-560)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of Parole and Probation of the Department of Public Safety for the acquisition and installation of electronic devices to access gated communities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Parole and Probation of the Department of Public Safety the sum of \$24,300 for:

(a) The acquisition of electronic devices that allow entry into a gated community; and

(b) The installation of such devices in official vehicles of the Division.

2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was

- 2 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
- 3 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.
- 4     **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
