AN ACT making supplemental appropriations to the Office of the Attorney General; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Office of the Attorney General's administration  
3 account the sum of \$685,979 for a cost allocation posting error in  
4 the amount of \$482,979, and a shortfall in revenue received from  
5 boards and commissions in the amount of \$203,000. This  
6 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 4 of chapter  
7 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1936.

8       2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
9 the Office of the Attorney General's special litigation account the  
10 sum of \$200,000 for costs relating to Yucca Mountain nuclear waste  
11 litigation. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by  
12 section 4 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1936.

13     3. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
14 the Office of the Extradition Coordinator in the Office of the  
15 Attorney General the sum of \$227,386 to replenish Fiscal Year  
16 2006-2007 extradition funds used in 2006, and to supplement funds  
17 for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 due to increased extradition costs. This
