

SENATE BILL NO. 346—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Office of the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services to fund a working group to study the methamphetamine problem in Nevada for the current fiscal year. (BDR S-1201)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Office of the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services to fund a working group to study the methamphetamine problem in Nevada for the current fiscal year; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Office of the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of \$9,900 to fund a working group to study the methamphetamine problem in Nevada for the current fiscal year.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2007, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 21, 2007, by either the entity to which the money



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- 1 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
- 2 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
- 3 Fund on or before September 21, 2007.
- 4 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
