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AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation to promote workforce and education initiatives; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Department of Employment, Training and  
3 Rehabilitation the sum of \$500,000 for the purpose of making grants  
4 of money to industry sector councils for workforce and education  
5 initiatives.

6       2. The Department shall distribute the allocation made by  
7 subsection 1 to industry sector councils established by the  
8 Governor's Workforce Investment Board. The industry sector  
9 councils shall use the money to promote efforts that advance  
10 workforce and education initiatives with employers, labor  
11 organizations, postsecondary educational institutions, trade  
12 associations and other stakeholders that share common occupations,  
13 employment and training needs.

14      **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
15 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
16 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or  
17 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or

1 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
2 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
3 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money  
4 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
5 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
6 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
