

SENATE BILL NO. 351—SENATOR HORSFORD

MARCH 19, 2007

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation to promote workforce and education initiatives. (BDR S-1316)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation to promote workforce and education initiatives; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation the sum of \$500,000 for the purpose of making grants of money to industry sector councils for workforce and education initiatives.

2. The Department shall distribute the allocation made by subsection 1 to industry sector councils established by the Governor's Workforce Investment Board. The industry sector councils shall use the money to promote efforts that advance workforce and education initiatives with employers, labor organizations, postsecondary educational institutions, trade associations and other stakeholders that share common occupations, employment and training needs.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or



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1 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
2 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
3 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
4 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
5 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
6 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
