AN ACT relating to wildlife; prohibiting the Department of Wildlife from exercising jurisdiction over animal husbandry relating to animals intended to produce food for human consumption; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law provides the Department of Wildlife with the jurisdiction to  
2 administer the wildlife laws of this State. (NRS 501.331) This bill prohibits the  
3 Department from exercising its jurisdiction or administering the wildlife laws of  
4 this State if the exercise of such jurisdiction or the administration of such laws  
5 would prohibit or interfere with a person's use of established methods of animal  
6 husbandry relating to any animal intended to produce food for human consumption.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 501.331 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2      501.331 **1.** There is hereby created the Department of  
3      Wildlife. **[which]**  
4      **2. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the**  
5      **Department** shall administer the wildlife laws of this State and  
6      chapter 488 of NRS.  
7      **3. The Department shall not exercise its jurisdiction or**  
8      **administer the wildlife laws of this State or chapter 488 of NRS if**

1    *the exercise of such jurisdiction or the administration of such laws*  
2    *would prohibit or interfere with a person's use of established*  
3    *methods of animal husbandry relating to any animal intended to*  
4    *produce food for human consumption, including, without*  
5    *limitation, the breeding, stocking, nurturing, raising, handling,*  
6    *herding, feeding, gathering, housing or transporting of such*  
7    *animals.*

8    **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
