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**SENATE BILL NO. 366—SENATOR BEERS****MARCH 19, 2007**

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**Referred to Committee on Natural Resources****SUMMARY**—Limits the authority of the Department of Wildlife over Australian red claw crayfish raised for sale as food for human consumption. 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**AN ACT** relating to wildlife; limiting the authority of the Department of Wildlife over Australian red claw crayfish that is raised in captivity on private property for sale as food for human consumption; prohibiting a person from importing, possessing or propagating freshwater lobster without a permit from the State Board of Agriculture; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law provides the Department of Wildlife with the jurisdiction to  
2 administer the wildlife laws of this State. (NRS 501.331) This bill limits the  
3 authority of the Department over Australian red claw crayfish that is raised in  
4 captivity on private property for sale as food for human consumption.

5 Existing law makes it unlawful for a person to import, possess or propagate any  
6 alternative livestock in this State without a permit issued by the State Board of  
7 Agriculture. (NRS 576.129) This bill imposes a similar restriction upon the  
8 importation, possession or propagation of Australian red claw crayfish.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 501 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      ***As used in this title, “freshwater lobster” means Australian red***  
4 ***claw crayfish (*Cherax quadricarinatus*) that is raised in captivity***  
5 ***on private property for sale as food for human consumption.***

1       **Sec. 2.** NRS 501.379 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2       501.379 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section:

3           (a) It is unlawful for any person to sell or expose for sale, to  
4       barter, trade or purchase or to attempt to sell, barter, trade or  
5       purchase any species of wildlife, or parts thereof, except as  
6       otherwise provided in this title or in a regulation of the Commission.

7           (b) The importation and sale of products made from the meat of  
8       game mammals, game birds or game amphibians raised in captivity  
9       is not prohibited if the importation is from a licensed commercial  
10      breeder or commercial processor.

11       2. The provisions of this section do not apply to *freshwater*  
12 *lobster or to* alternative livestock and products made therefrom.

13       **Sec. 3.** NRS 503.590 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14       503.590 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a  
15      person may maintain a noncommercial collection of legally obtained  
16      live wildlife if:

17           (a) Such a collection is not maintained for public display nor as  
18       a part of or adjunct to any commercial establishment; and

19           (b) The wildlife contained in such a collection is of a species  
20       which may be possessed in accordance with regulations adopted by  
21       the Commission pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 504.295.

22       2. The Commission may adopt reasonable regulations  
23       establishing minimum standards for the fencing or containment of  
24       any collection of wildlife.

25       3. The provisions of this section do not apply to *freshwater*  
26 *lobster or to* alternative livestock and products made therefrom.

27       **Sec. 4.** NRS 503.597 is hereby amended to read as follows:

28       503.597 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, it is  
29       unlawful, except by the written consent and approval of the  
30       Department, for any person at anytime to receive, bring or have  
31       brought or shipped into this State, or remove from one stream or  
32       body of water in this State to any other, or from one portion of the  
33       State to any other, or to any other state, any aquatic life or wildlife,  
34       or any spawn, eggs or young of any of them.

35       2. The Department shall require an applicant to conduct an  
36       investigation to confirm that such an introduction or removal will  
37       not be detrimental to the wildlife or the habitat of wildlife in this  
38       State. Written consent and approval of the Department may be given  
39       only if the results of the investigation prove that the introduction,  
40       removal or importation will not be detrimental to existing aquatic  
41       life or wildlife, or any spawn, eggs or young of any of them.

42       3. The Commission may through appropriate regulation  
43       provide for the inspection of such introduced or removed creatures  
44       and the inspection fees therefor.

1       4. The Commission may adopt regulations to prohibit the  
2 importation, transportation or possession of any species of wildlife  
3 which the Commission deems to be detrimental to the wildlife or the  
4 habitat of the wildlife in this State.

5       5. The provisions of this section do not apply to ***freshwater***  
6 ***lobster or to*** alternative livestock and products made therefrom.

7       **Sec. 5.** NRS 504.245 is hereby amended to read as follows:

8       504.245 1. Any species of wildlife, including ***freshwater***  
9 ***lobster and*** alternative livestock, that:

10      (a) Is released from confinement without the prior written  
11 authorization of the Department; or

12      (b) Escapes from the possessor's control,

13      → may be captured, seized or destroyed by the Department if the  
14 Department determines that such actions are necessary to protect  
15 wildlife and the habitat of wildlife in this State.

16      2. The owner or possessor of such wildlife:

17      (a) Shall report its escape immediately after receiving  
18 knowledge of the escape; and

19      (b) Is liable for the costs incurred by the Department to capture,  
20 maintain and dispose of the wildlife and for any damage caused by  
21 the wildlife.

22      3. The Department is not liable for any damage to wildlife, or  
23 caused by wildlife, in carrying out the provisions of this section.

24       **Sec. 6.** NRS 504.295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

25       504.295 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section and  
26 NRS 503.590, or unless otherwise specified by a regulation adopted  
27 by the Commission, no person may:

28      (a) Possess any live wildlife unless he is licensed by the  
29 Department to do so.

30      (b) Capture live wildlife in this State to stock a commercial or  
31 noncommercial wildlife facility.

32      (c) Possess or release from confinement any mammal for the  
33 purposes of hunting.

34      2. The Commission shall adopt regulations for the possession  
35 of live wildlife. The regulations must set forth the species of wildlife  
36 which may be possessed and propagated, and provide for the  
37 inspection by the Department of any related facilities.

38      3. In accordance with the regulations of the Commission, the  
39 Department may issue commercial and noncommercial licenses for  
40 the possession of live wildlife upon receipt of the applicable fee.

41      4. The provisions of this section do not apply to ***freshwater***  
42 ***lobster or to*** alternative livestock and products made therefrom.

1      **Sec. 7.** Chapter 576 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      ***"Freshwater lobster" has the meaning ascribed to it in section  
4      1 of this act.***

5      **Sec. 8.** NRS 576.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

6      576.010 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise  
7      requires, the words and terms defined in NRS 576.0115 to 576.018,  
8      inclusive, ***and section 7 of this act*** have the meanings ascribed to  
9      them in those sections.

10     **Sec. 9.** NRS 576.129 is hereby amended to read as follows:

11     576.129 1. It is unlawful for any person to import, possess or  
12     propagate any ***freshwater lobster or*** alternative livestock unless he  
13     first obtains from the State Board of Agriculture a permit that  
14     authorizes him to do so.

15     2. The State Board of Agriculture shall adopt regulations for  
16     the importation, possession and propagation of alternative livestock.  
17     The regulations must set forth requirements for:

18        (a) Facilities used to confine alternative livestock, including  
19        minimum requirements for fencing to prevent the escape of  
20        alternative livestock.

21        (b) The genetic testing of alternative livestock.

22        (c) Keeping and maintaining records related to the importation,  
23        transfer, possession and propagation of alternative livestock.

24        (d) Identifying and marking alternative livestock.

25        (e) Marketing alternative livestock.

26        (f) The filing of any bonds which may be required by the State  
27        Board of Agriculture.

28        3. In adopting the regulations required by subsection 2, the  
29        State Board of Agriculture shall consult with the Department of  
30        Wildlife and the Board of Wildlife Commissioners concerning the  
31        provisions that are necessary to protect wildlife in this state and in  
32        the areas designated as areas of special concern by the Board of  
33        Wildlife Commissioners pursuant to NRS 501.181.

34        4. The State Board of Agriculture shall ***adopt regulations for  
35        the importation, possession and propagation of freshwater lobster.  
36        The regulations must set forth requirements for:***

37            (a) ***Facilities used to confine freshwater lobster, including the  
38            minimum requirements for any tank or pond for the freshwater  
39            lobster.***

40            (b) ***Keeping and maintaining records related to the  
41            importation, transfer, possession and propagation of freshwater  
42            lobster.***

43            (c) ***Marketing freshwater lobster.***

44            (d) ***The filing of any bonds which may be required by the State  
45            Board of Agriculture.***

1       **5. The State Board of Agriculture shall** establish by regulation  
2 a schedule of fees required to be paid for a permit issued pursuant to  
3 this section. The fees established must not exceed the approximate  
4 cost to the Board of carrying out the provisions of this section.

5       **Sec. 10.** NRS 576.131 is hereby amended to read as follows:

6       576.131 1. An owner of **freshwater lobster or** alternative  
7 livestock may request assistance from the State Department of  
8 Agriculture, the Department of Wildlife and local law enforcement  
9 agencies to recapture any **freshwater lobster or** alternative livestock  
10 that has escaped from confinement.

11      2. Any **freshwater lobster or** alternative livestock that is  
12 recaptured may be impounded at a suitable facility until sufficient  
13 repairs or improvements are made to the owner's facility to ensure  
14 that the escape of the **freshwater lobster or** alternative livestock  
15 does not recur.

16      3. The owner of the **freshwater lobster or** alternative livestock  
17 is liable for:

18       (a) The costs incurred by the State Department of Agriculture,  
19 the Department of Wildlife and any local law enforcement agency to  
20 recapture the **freshwater lobster or** alternative livestock;

21       (b) The costs of impounding the **freshwater lobster or**  
22 alternative livestock; and

23       (c) Any damages caused by the **freshwater lobster or** alternative  
24 livestock during the escape.

25       **Sec. 11.** 1. Any commercial or noncommercial license for  
26 the possession of freshwater lobster issued by the Department of  
27 Wildlife remains valid until the earlier of:

28       (a) The date the State Board of Agriculture issues to the holder  
29 of the license a permit for the importation, possession or  
30 propagation of freshwater lobster pursuant to NRS 576.129, as  
31 amended by section 9 of this act; or

32       (b) June 1, 2008.

33       2. As used in this section, "freshwater lobster" means  
34 Australian red claw crayfish (*Cherax quadricarinatus*) that is raised  
35 in captivity on private property for sale as food for human  
36 consumption.

37       **Sec. 12.** This act becomes effective:

38       1. Upon passage and approval for the purpose of adopting  
39 regulations by the State Board of Agriculture pursuant to section 9  
40 of this act; and

41       2. On January 1, 2008, for all other purposes.
