

SENATE BILL NO. 4—SENATOR CEGAVSKE

SUMMARY—Revises the provision related to express warranties for motor vehicles. (BDR 52-293)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing costs and reasonable attorney's fees for buyers who prevail in certain actions related to express warranties for motor vehicles; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Under existing law, a buyer of a motor vehicle may bring an action related to
2 an express warranty for a motor vehicle. (NRS 597.650) This bill provides that a
3 buyer who prevails in such an action shall receive costs and reasonable attorney's
4 fees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 597.650 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 597.650 **1.** Any action brought pursuant to NRS 597.600 to
3 597.630, inclusive, must be commenced within 18 months after the
4 date of the original delivery of the motor vehicle to the buyer.
5 **2. *If a buyer prevails in an action brought pursuant to NRS***
6 ***597.600 to 597.630, inclusive, the court shall award the buyer***
7 ***costs and reasonable attorney's fees.***
