AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of State Parks of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the development of a new group picnic area at Spring Mountain Ranch State Park; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Division of State Parks of the State Department
3 of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$1,151,000 for
4 the development of a new group picnic area at Spring Mountain
5 Ranch State Park.

6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
8 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
9 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
10 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
11 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
12 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
13 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently

- 1 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
- 2 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.
- 3 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
