AN ACT making an appropriation to support the Nevada Arts Council; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Nevada Cultural Fund created by NRS 233C.095:

For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$2,623,050

For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$2,623,050

2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be used to support the Nevada Arts Council of the Department of Cultural Affairs in carrying out the provisions of NRS 233C.096.

Sec. 2. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 of section 1 of this act are available for either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was



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1 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
2 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
3 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

4 **Sec. 3.** The appropriations made by the provisions of this act
5 are intended to finance ongoing expenditures of state agencies, and
6 the expenditures financed with those appropriations must be
7 included as base budget expenditures in the proposed budget for the
8 Executive Branch of State Government for the 2007-2009 biennium
9 at the rate of \$1 per resident of this State, as indicated by the most
10 recent estimates of the State Demographer employed pursuant to
11 NRS 360.283.

12 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
