

## SENATE BILL NO. 454—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

MARCH 26, 2007

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Referred to Committee on Finance

**SUMMARY**—Revises the dates upon which certain uncommitted funds from prior appropriations must be reverted.  
(BDR S-1070)

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AN ACT relating to state financial administration; revising the dates upon which certain uncommitted funds from prior transfers and appropriations must be reverted; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1        During the 2005 Legislative Session, the Legislature required the Commission  
2 on Tourism to transfer a portion of the proceeds of the room tax to the Interim  
3 Finance Committee for allocation to the Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors  
4 Authority to implement the Truckee River Recreational Master Plan. The  
5 Legislature provided that the tax proceeds must not be committed for expenditure  
6 after June 30, 2007, and must be reverted on or before September 21, 2007. **Section**  
7 **1** of this bill extends the reversion date by 2 years and adds a final reporting  
8 requirement. In 2005, the Legislature also appropriated money from the State  
9 General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee for allocation to the Reno-Sparks  
10 Convention and Visitors Authority to implement the Truckee River Recreational  
11 Master Plan. The Legislature provided that this money must not be committed for  
12 expenditure after June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on  
13 or before September 21, 2007. **Section 2** of this bill extends the reversion date by 2  
14 years and adds a final reporting requirement.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        **Section 1.** Section 5 of chapter 454, Statutes of Nevada 2005,  
2 at page 2089, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3              Sec. 5. 1. The Commission on Tourism shall, as soon  
4              as practicable after July 1, 2005, and July 1, 2006,

1 respectively, without depleting the funds necessary for day-  
2 to-day operations, transfer the following amounts from the  
3 proceeds from the taxes imposed on the revenue from  
4 the rental of transient lodging which have been credited to the  
5 Fund for the Promotion of Tourism, created by NRS 231.250,  
6 to the Interim Finance Committee:

7 For the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 ..... \$600,000

8 For the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 ..... \$50,000

9 2. The money transferred pursuant to subsection 1 shall  
10 be allocated to the Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors  
11 Authority to implement the Truckee River Recreational  
12 Master Plan as adopted by the City of Reno, the City of  
13 Sparks and Washoe County through a public review process.  
14 The money must be used to plan, obtain permits for, design  
15 and construct not more than four projects along the Truckee  
16 River that would enhance the recreational enjoyment, aquatic  
17 habitat and water quality of the Truckee River. The money  
18 must be expended on the following projects but is not limited  
19 to Rock Park, Pioneer Diversion Dam, Ambrose Park and  
20 Idlewild Park.

21 3. The Interim Finance Committee shall allocate the  
22 money transferred pursuant to subsection 1 upon notification  
23 that the City of Reno, the City of Sparks and Washoe County  
24 have committed to expend, in total, an equal amount of  
25 money on Truckee River improvement related projects. For  
26 the purpose of this section, Truckee River improvement  
27 related projects include any public project to improve the  
28 Truckee River for watershed protection, watershed  
29 restoration, recreation or flood control.

30 4. Upon acceptance of the money allocated pursuant to  
31 subsection 2, the Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors  
32 Authority shall prepare and transmit ~~[a]~~:

33 (a) A report to the Interim Finance Committee on or  
34 before December 15, 2006, that describes each expenditure  
35 made from the money allocated pursuant to subsection 2 from  
36 the date on which the money was received by the  
37 Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority through  
38 December 1, 2006 ~~H~~; and

39 (b) *A final report to the Interim Finance Committee on*  
40 *or before October 1, 2009, that describes each expenditure*  
41 *made from the money allocated pursuant to subsection 2*  
42 *from the date on which the money was received by the*  
43 *Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority through*  
44 *September 18, 2009.*



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1       5. The Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority  
2 shall not assess an administrative fee or fine upon any local  
3 governing bodies relating to compliance with the provisions  
4 of subsections 3 and 4.

5       6. A public review and approval process, as determined  
6 by the City of Reno, the City of Sparks and Washoe County,  
7 must be completed before the commencement of construction  
8 of any project that uses money allocated pursuant to this  
9 section. Project design, construction documents and funding  
10 processes related to any such project must be approved by  
11 each local governing body having jurisdiction over the  
12 project. Each such project must conform to the parameters of  
13 the Truckee River Flood Control Project and the Truckee  
14 River Operating Agreement.

15      7. Any remaining balance of the sums transferred  
16 pursuant to subsection 1 must not be committed for  
17 expenditure after June 30, ~~2007,~~ 2009, and must be reverted  
18 to the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism on or before  
19 September ~~21, 2007,~~ 18, 2009.

20 **Sec. 2.** Section 32 of chapter 7, Statutes of Nevada 2005, 22nd  
21 Special Session, at page 120, is hereby amended to read as follows:

22      Sec. 32. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the  
23 State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the  
24 sum of \$600,000 for allocation to the Reno-Sparks  
25 Convention and Visitors Authority to implement the Truckee  
26 River Recreational Master Plan as adopted by the City of  
27 Reno, the City of Sparks and Washoe County through a  
28 public review process. The money must be used to plan,  
29 obtain permits for, design and construct not more than four  
30 projects along the Truckee River that would enhance the  
31 recreational enjoyment, aquatic habitat and water quality of  
32 the Truckee River. The money must be expended on the  
33 following projects but is not limited to Rock Park, Pioneer  
34 Diversion Dam, Ambrose Park and Idlewild Park.

35      2. The Interim Finance Committee shall allocate the  
36 money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1 upon  
37 notification that the City of Reno, the City of Sparks and  
38 Washoe County have committed to expend, in total, an equal  
39 amount of money on Truckee River improvement related  
40 projects. For the purpose of this section, Truckee River  
41 improvement related projects include any public project to  
42 improve the Truckee River for watershed protection,  
43 watershed restoration, recreation or flood control.



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1       3. Upon acceptance of the money allocated pursuant to  
2 subsection 2, the Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors  
3 Authority shall prepare and transmit ~~[a]~~:

4       (a) A report to the Interim Finance Committee on or  
5 before December 15, 2006, that describes each expenditure  
6 made from the money allocated pursuant to subsection 2 from  
7 the date on which the money was received by the  
8 Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority through  
9 December 1, 2006 ~~H~~; and

10      (b) *A final report to the Interim Finance Committee on  
11 or before October 1, 2009, that describes each expenditure  
12 made from the money allocated pursuant to subsection 2  
13 from the date on which the money was received by the  
14 Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority through  
15 September 18, 2009.*

16      4. The Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority  
17 shall not assess an administrative fee or fine upon any local  
18 governing bodies relating to compliance with the provisions  
19 of subsections 2 and 3.

20      5. A public review and approval process, as determined  
21 by the City of Reno, the City of Sparks and Washoe County,  
22 must be completed before the commencement of construction  
23 of any project that uses money allocated pursuant to this  
24 section. Project design, construction documents and funding  
25 processes related to any such project must be approved by  
26 each local governing body having jurisdiction over the  
27 project. Each such project must conform to the parameters of  
28 the Truckee River Flood Control Project and the Truckee  
29 River Operating Agreement.

30      6. Any remaining balance of the sums appropriated  
31 pursuant to subsection 1 must not be committed for  
32 expenditure after June 30, ~~[2007.]~~ 2009, and must be reverted  
33 to the State General Fund on or before  
34 September ~~[21, 2007.]~~ 18, 2009.

35 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
