

SENATE BILL NO. 459—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

MARCH 26, 2007

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Purchasing Division of the Department of Administration for costs associated with the Commodity Supplemental Food Program. (BDR S-1444)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Purchasing Division of the Department of Administration for costs associated with the Commodity Supplemental Food Program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Purchasing Division of the Department of Administration to supplement distribution costs in northern Nevada for the federal Commodity Supplemental Food Program:

For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$100,000

For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$100,000

Sec. 2. The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are available for either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and



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1 must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
2 September 18, 2009.

3 **Sec. 3.** The appropriations made by the provisions of this act
4 are intended to finance ongoing expenditures of state agencies, and
5 the expenditures financed with those appropriations must be
6 included as base budget expenditures in the proposed budget for the
7 Executive Branch of State Government for the 2009-2011 biennium.

8 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
