AN ACT making an appropriation to the Legislative Fund for various projects of the Legislature and the Legislative Counsel Bureau; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Legislative Fund, created pursuant to NRS
3 218.085, the sum of \$6,533,978 to be allocated as follows:

4 For the cost of reproducing out-of-print
5 publications\$50,000
6 For information technology projects\$1,531,654
7 For advance planning for a new staff office
8 building\$3,000,000
9 For the replacement of screens in the legislative
10 chambers and miscellaneous construction and
11 maintenance projects.....\$1,952,324

12 **Sec. 2.** The Legislative Counsel Bureau shall solicit bids, as
13 appropriate, for all contracts for construction that are funded in
14 whole or in part by money appropriated by section 1 of this act and
15 shall comply with the provisions of NRS 338.010 to 338.090,

1 inclusive, for all construction work performed under such contracts.
2 All contracts entered into to carry out the provisions of this act must
3 include a provision that prevailing wages must be paid on all work
4 performed under the contracts in compliance with the provisions of
5 NRS 338.010 to 338.090, inclusive. The remaining provisions of
6 chapter 338 of NRS and the provisions of chapter 341 of NRS do
7 not apply to such construction.

8 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
