

SENATE BILL NO. 465—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

MARCH 26, 2007

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Provides for the preparation of a legislative proposal for the budget for the State Government. (BDR 17-1071)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [~~omitted material~~] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the Legislature; requiring the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau to prepare a legislative proposal for the budget for the State Government; requiring the Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of Administration to provide certain information to the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau; repealing the provision that creates the Budget Subcommittee of the Legislative Commission; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 **Section 2** of this bill requires the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative
2 Counsel Bureau to prepare a legislative proposal for the budget for the State
3 Government and to set forth the timeline in which the proposal must be prepared, as
4 well as the contents that must be included in the proposal. **Section 3** of this bill
5 establishes a new provision that requires the Interim Finance Committee to advise
6 the Fiscal Analysis Division on matters pertaining to the preparation of the
7 legislative proposal and to review relevant fiscal issues.

8 **Section 5** of this bill adds to the list of duties that must be performed by the
9 Fiscal Analysis Division the duty to prepare the legislative proposal for the budget
10 for the State Government. (NRS 218.686)

11 Existing law sets forth the required contents of the proposed budget for the
12 Executive Department of the State Government for each fiscal year. (NRS 353.205)
13 **Section 6** of this bill eliminates the requirement that a copy of each part of the
14 proposed budget must be transmitted to the Fiscal Analysis Division as soon as it is
15 prepared. **Section 6** also eliminates the provision relating to confidentiality.

16 **Section 7** of this bill changes the date when the Chief of the Budget Division of
17 the Department of Administration must provide to the Fiscal Analysis Division



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18 information relating to budget files for the previous year, work programs for the
19 current year and each agency's requested budget for the next 2 fiscal years, from
20 October 15 of each even-numbered year to September 1 of each even-numbered
21 year. (NRS 353.211) **Section 7** also changes the date when the Chief must provide
22 to the Fiscal Analysis Division each agency's adjusted base budget by budgetary
23 account for the next 2 fiscal years and an estimated range for certain anticipated
24 costs, from December 31 of each even-numbered year to December 15 of each
25 even-numbered year. **Section 7** further requires the Chief to carry out certain duties
26 in accordance with the preparation of the proposed budget of the Executive
27 Department of the State Government.

28 **Section 8** of this bill repeals the provision that creates the Budget
29 Subcommittee of the Legislative Commission. (NRS 218.6824)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 218 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this act.

3 **Sec. 2.** *1. The Fiscal Analysis Division shall prepare the
4 legislative proposal for the budget for the State Government for
5 each biennium for presentation to the Legislature for its
6 consideration not later than the second day of each regular
7 session of the Legislature.*

8 *2. The legislative proposal for the budget must include:*

9 *(a) A complete financial plan for the next 2 fiscal years;*

10 *(b) All proposed expenditures for the administration, operation
11 and maintenance of the departments, institutions and agencies of
12 the State Government, including, without limitation, those
13 operating on money designated for specific purposes by the
14 Constitution of this State or otherwise;*

15 *(c) All interest and debt redemption charges during the next 2
16 fiscal years;*

17 *(d) All expenditures for capital projects to be undertaken and
18 executed during the next 2 fiscal years; and*

19 *(e) The anticipated revenue of the State Government and any
20 other additional means of financing the expenditures proposed for
21 the next 2 fiscal years.*

22 **Sec. 3.** *The Interim Finance Committee shall:*

23 *1. Advise the Fiscal Analysis Division on matters pertaining
24 to the preparation of the legislative proposal for the budget for the
25 State Government pursuant to section 2 of this act;*

26 *2. Review fiscal issues that may require consideration by the
27 Legislature at the next regular session of the Legislature; and*

28 *3. Carry out the duties set forth in this section before the
29 commencement of the next regular session of the Legislature.*



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1 **Sec. 4.** NRS 218.610 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 218.610 As used in NRS 218.610 to 218.735, inclusive, ***and***
3 ***sections 2 and 3 of this act***, “agency of the State” includes all
4 offices, departments, boards, commissions and institutions of the
5 State.

6 **Sec. 5.** NRS 218.686 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 218.686 1. The Fiscal Analysis Division consists of the
8 Senate Fiscal Analyst, the Assembly Fiscal Analyst and such
9 additional staff as the performance of their duties may require.

10 2. The Fiscal Analysis Division shall:

11 (a) Thoroughly examine all agencies of the State with special
12 regard to their activities and the duplication of efforts between them.

13 (b) Recommend to the Legislature any suggested changes
14 looking toward economy and the elimination of inefficiency in
15 government.

16 (c) Ascertain facts and make recommendations to the
17 Legislature concerning the budget of the State and the estimates of
18 the expenditure requirements of the agencies of the State.

19 (d) ***Prepare the legislative proposal for the budget for the State
20 Government pursuant to section 2 of this act.***

21 (e) Make projections of future public revenues for the use of the
22 Legislature.

23 ~~(e)~~ (f) Analyze the history and probable future trend of the
24 State's financial position in order that a sound fiscal policy may be
25 developed and maintained for the State of Nevada.

26 ~~(f)~~ (g) Analyze appropriation bills, revenue bills, and bills
27 having a fiscal impact upon the operation of the government of the
28 State of Nevada or its political subdivisions.

29 ~~(g)~~ (h) Advise the Legislature and the members and
30 committees thereof regarding matters of a fiscal nature.

31 ~~(h)~~ (i) Perform such other functions as may be assigned to the
32 Fiscal Analysis Division by the Legislature, the Legislative
33 Commission or the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau.

34 **Sec. 6.** NRS 353.205 is hereby amended to read as follows:

35 353.205 ~~(1)~~ The proposed budget for the Executive
36 Department of the State Government for each fiscal year must be set
37 up in three parts:

38 ~~(a)~~ I. Part 1 must consist of a budgetary message by the
39 Governor ~~which~~ ***that*** outlines the financial policy of the Executive
40 Department of the State Government for the next 2 fiscal years,
41 describing in connection therewith the important features of the
42 financial plan. It must also embrace a general summary of the
43 proposed budget setting forth the aggregate figures of the proposed
44 budget in such a manner as to show the balanced relations between
45 the total proposed expenditures and the total anticipated revenues,



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1 together with the other means of financing the proposed budget for
2 the next 2 fiscal years, contrasted with the corresponding figures for
3 the last completed fiscal year and fiscal year in progress. The
4 general summary of the proposed budget must be supported by
5 explanatory schedules or statements, classifying the expenditures
6 contained therein by organizational units, objects and funds, and the
7 income by organizational units, sources and funds.

8 ~~(b)~~ 2. Part 2 must embrace the detailed budgetary estimates
9 both of expenditures and revenues as provided in NRS 353.150 to
10 353.246, inclusive. The information must be presented in a manner
11 which sets forth separately the cost of continuing each program at
12 the same level of service as the current year and the cost, by
13 budgetary issue, of any recommendations to enhance or reduce that
14 level of service. Revenues must be summarized by type, and
15 expenditures must be summarized by category of expense. Part 2
16 must include a mission statement and measurement indicators for
17 each program. It must also include statements of the bonded
18 indebtedness of the State Government, showing the requirements for
19 redemption of debt, the debt authorized and unissued, and the
20 condition of the sinking funds, and any statements relative to the
21 financial plan which the Governor may deem desirable, or which
22 may be required by the Legislature.

23 ~~(c)~~ 3. Part 3 must include a recommendation to the
24 Legislature for the drafting of a general appropriation bill
25 authorizing, by departments, institutions and agencies, and by funds,
26 all expenditures of the Executive Department of the State
27 Government for the next 2 fiscal years, and may include
28 recommendations to the Legislature for the drafting of such other
29 bills as may be required to provide the income necessary to finance
30 the proposed budget and to give legal sanction to the financial plan
31 if adopted by the Legislature.

32 ~~1. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 353.211, as soon as
33 each part of the proposed budget is prepared, a copy of the part must
34 be transmitted to the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative
35 Counsel Bureau for confidential examination and retention.~~

36 ~~2. Except for the information provided to the Fiscal Analysis
37 Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS
38 353.211, parts 1 and 2 of the proposed budget are confidential until
39 the Governor transmits the proposed budget to the Legislature
40 pursuant to NRS 353.230, regardless of whether those parts are in
41 the possession of the Executive or Legislative Department of the
42 State Government. Part 3 of the proposed budget is confidential
43 until the bills which result from the proposed budget are introduced
44 in the Legislature.]~~



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1 **Sec. 7.** NRS 353.211 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 353.211 1. On or before ~~October 15~~ **September 1** of each
3 even-numbered year, the Chief shall provide to the Fiscal Analysis
4 Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau:

5 (a) Computerized budget files containing the actual data
6 regarding revenues and expenditures for the previous year;
7 (b) The work programs for the current year; and
8 (c) Each agency's requested budget for the next 2 fiscal years.

9 2. On or before December ~~31~~ **15** of each even-numbered
10 year, the Chief shall provide to the Fiscal Analysis **Division in
11 printed form, in a form available for access by computer and in
12 any other form or on any other medium requested by the Fiscal
13 Analysis** Division:

14 (a) Each agency's adjusted base budget by budgetary account
15 for the next 2 fiscal years ~~is~~ and **any readily available, related
16 information requested by the Fiscal Analysis Division; and**

17 (b) An estimated range of the costs for:
18 (1) Continuing the operation of State Government; and
19 (2) Providing elementary, secondary and higher public
20 education,

21 → at the current level of service.

22 3. **The Chief shall:**

23 (a) **Consult with the Fiscal Analysis Division when preparing
24 the proposed budget of the Executive Department of the State
25 Government to establish identical organizational coding schemes
26 and coding schemes for the computer to be used in the proposed
27 budget of the Executive Department of the State Government and
28 the legislative proposal for the budget prepared pursuant to
29 section 2 of this act.**

30 (b) **As soon as each part of the proposed budget of the
31 Executive Department of the State Government is prepared and
32 not later than the date the part is sent to the printer, provide that
33 part to the Fiscal Analysis Division.**

34 4. **The Chief shall provide each part of the proposed budget
35 and the final version of the proposed budget pursuant to
36 subsection 3 in printed form, in a form available for access by
37 computer, and in any other form or on any other medium
38 requested by the Fiscal Analysis Division. The final version of the
39 proposed budget must be available in a form that allows
40 automated comparison with the legislative proposal for the budget
41 prepared pursuant to section 2 of this act.**

42 5. **The Fiscal Analysis Division shall not disclose the contents
43 of part 3 of the final version of the proposed budget described in
44 subsection 3 of NRS 353.205 until the bills that result from the**



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1 *final version of the proposed budget are introduced in the*
2 *Legislature.*

3 6. The information provided to the Fiscal Analysis Division
4 pursuant to subsections 1 and 2 is open for public inspection.

5 Sec. 8. NRS 218.6824 is hereby repealed.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

218.6824 Legislative Commission: Budget Subcommittee.

1. There is hereby created a Budget Subcommittee of the Legislative Commission.

2. The Chairman of the Legislative Commission shall appoint to the Subcommittee the persons designated by the Speaker designate of the Assembly to be members of the Assembly Standing Committee on Ways and Means and the persons designated by the Majority Leader designate of the Senate to be members of the Senate Standing Committee on Finance for the next ensuing session of the Legislature.

3. The Budget Subcommittee shall conclude its activities before the next regular legislative session is convened.

4. The Budget Subcommittee shall consider fiscal issues that may require consideration by the Legislature at the next ensuing session.

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
