SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to certain public facilities. (BDR 20-1352)

AN ACT relating to public facilities; authorizing the boards of county commissioners of certain larger counties to adopt procedures for the sale of the naming rights to a shooting range owned by the county; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Under existing law, boards of county commissioners are authorized to acquire
2 parcels of land for park, recreational, cultural and memorial purposes and to
3 operate, maintain and improve parks and other recreational and cultural facilities
4 and areas owned by the county. (NRS 244.300-244.3091) **Section 2** of this bill
5 authorizes a board of county commissioners in a county whose population is
6 400,000 or more (currently Clark County) to adopt by ordinance procedures for the
7 sale of the naming rights to a shooting range owned by the county.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** (Deleted by amendment.)
2 **Sec. 2.** Chapter 244 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
3 thereto a new section to read as follows:
4 ***The board of county commissioners in a county whose***
5 ***population is 400,000 or more may adopt, by ordinance,***
6 ***procedures for the sale of the naming rights to a shooting range***
7 ***that is owned by the county.***
