

SENATE BILL NO. 512—COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS
(ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS)

MARCH 26, 2007

SUMMARY—Authorizes incorporated cities to enter into lease-purchase agreements for the construction or remodeling of buildings or facilities. (BDR 21-488)

AN ACT relating to cities; authorizing the governing bodies of incorporated cities to enter into lease-purchase agreements for the construction or remodeling of buildings or facilities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill authorizes the governing body of an incorporated city or its authorized
2 representative to enter into a lease or lease-purchase agreement with a person to
3 construct or remodel a building or facility. This bill provides that prevailing wage
4 requirements apply to any such construction or remodeling project.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 268 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. The governing body of any incorporated city or its
4 authorized representative may enter into an agreement with a
5 person whereby the person agrees to construct or remodel a
6 building or facility according to specifications adopted by the
7 governing body and thereupon enter into a lease or a lease-
8 purchase agreement with the governing body for that building or
9 facility.***

1 **2. The governing body may convey property to a person
2 where the purpose of the conveyance is the entering into of an
3 agreement contemplated by subsection 1.**

4 **3. The provisions of NRS 338.010 to 338.090, inclusive, apply
5 to any agreement for the construction or remodeling of a building
6 or facility entered into pursuant to subsection 1.**

7 **4. As used in this section “authorized representative” means
8 a person designated by the governing body to be responsible for
9 the development, solicitation, award or administration of lease or
10 lease-purchase agreements.**

11 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
