SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services for services to Medicaid recipients with traumatic brain injuries. (BDR S-309)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services for services to Medicaid recipients with traumatic brain injuries; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy
3 of the Department of Health and Human Services to fund the
4 addition of long-term, community-based residential habilitation and
5 behavioral adult day care service packages to the current Waiver for
6 People with Physical Disabilities to provide services for Medicaid
7 recipients over the age of 22 years with a diagnosis of traumatic
8 brain injury:
9 For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$1,003,676
10 For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$1,003,677

1 **Sec. 2.** The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are
2 available for either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums
3 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the
4 entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which
5 money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in
6 any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining
7 must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by
8 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity
9 to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
10 and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
11 September 18, 2009.

12 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
