AN ACT relating to health care; increasing the rate of Medicaid reimbursements for hospitals; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      This bill directs the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services  
2      to increase the Medicaid reimbursement rates to hospitals for inpatient services by  
3      8.5 percent over 2 years.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** The Director of the Department of Health and  
2      Human Services shall increase the Medicaid reimbursement rates  
3      paid to hospitals for inpatient services that are in effect on June 30,  
4      2007, by 5 percent for Fiscal Year 2007-2008, and by an additional  
5      3.5 percent for Fiscal Year 2008-2009, to better approximate the  
6      actual costs of providing care.

7      **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
