

SENATE BILL NO. 526—COMMITTEE ON
HUMAN RESOURCES AND EDUCATION

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Nevada System of Higher Education and the Orvis Nursing Clinic of the University of Nevada, Reno, for the expansion of nursing programs and health care services. (BDR S-769)

AN ACT making appropriations to the Nevada System of Higher Education and the Orvis Nursing Clinic of the University of Nevada, Reno, for the expansion of nursing programs and health care services; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Nevada System of Higher Education the sum of \$21,256,232 for carrying out the 2006 Nursing Plan prepared by the Office of the Chancellor to double the capacity of the System's nursing programs by 2012-2013.

2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently



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1 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
2 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

3 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
4 General Fund to the Orvis Nursing Clinic of the University of
5 Nevada, Reno, for the expansion of health care services:

6 For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$250,000

7 For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$250,000

8 2. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 are available for
9 either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums must not be
10 committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to
11 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from
12 the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner,
13 and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be
14 spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity
15 to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the
16 money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
17 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

18 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
