AN ACT relating to public schools; authorizing the superintendent of schools of a school district to extend the jurisdiction of school police officers for the purpose of issuing citations for traffic violations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law extends the jurisdiction of school police officers to all school  
2 property, buildings and facilities for the purpose of protecting personnel, pupils and  
3 property. (NRS 391.275) This bill authorizes the superintendent of schools of a  
4 school district to extend the jurisdiction to streets adjacent to school property,  
5 buildings and facilities for the purpose of issuing traffic citations during the times  
6 that school is in session or school-related activities are in progress.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 391.275 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2            391.275    **1.** The jurisdiction of each school police officer of a  
3 school district extends to all school property, buildings and facilities  
4 within the school district **[,]** for the purpose of:  
5            **[,] (a)** Protecting school district personnel, pupils **[,]** or real or  
6 personal property; or

1       **[2.] (b)** Cooperating with local law enforcement agencies in  
2 matters relating to personnel, pupils or real or personal property of  
3 the school district.

4       ***2. In addition to the jurisdiction set forth in subsection 1, the***  
5 ***superintendent of schools of a school district may extend the***  
6 ***jurisdiction of each school police officer of the school district to***  
7 ***the streets that are adjacent to school property, buildings and***  
8 ***facilities within the school district:***

9       ***(a) For the purpose of issuing traffic citations for violations of***  
10 ***traffic laws and ordinances; and***

11       ***(b) During the times that school is in session or school-related***  
12 ***activities are in progress.***

13       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
