

## SENATE BILL NO. 555—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

APRIL 9, 2007

Referred to Committee on Finance

**SUMMARY**—Makes appropriations to the Department of Public Safety. (BDR S-1266)

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AN ACT making appropriations to the Department of Public Safety from both the State General Fund and the State Highway Fund; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Investigation Division of the Department of  
3 Public Safety the sum of \$330,022 to partially fund replacement  
4 vehicles and associated equipment, and for personal computers,  
5 laptop computers, printers and related software.

6       2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
7 the Division of Emergency Management of the Department of  
8 Public Safety the sum of \$75,371 for computer hardware and  
9 software and ID cards and door locks.

10      3. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
11 the State Fire Marshal Division of the Department of Public Safety  
12 the sum of \$264,981 to replace seven older, unreliable agency-  
13 owned vehicles and to replace personal computers, laptop computers  
14 and printers.

15      4. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
16 the Division of Parole and Probation of the Department of Public



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1 Safety the sum of \$420,432 to replace worn and damaged office  
2 furniture and file cabinets, outdated or nonfunctional equipment,  
3 and 114 computers in each year of the biennium.

4       5. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
5 the Department of Public Safety for the State Board of Parole  
6 Commissioners the sum of \$96,076 to incorporate the Board's  
7 practices, decisions and analysis into the Nevada Offender Tracking  
8 and Information System and to replace computer hardware and  
9 software.

10      6. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
11 the Training Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum of  
12 \$6,715 to partially fund the replacement of computer hardware and  
13 software, classroom furniture and protective suits.

14     **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
15 Highway Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the  
16 Department of Public Safety the sum of \$15,177,322 to fund over  
17 300 new and replacement vehicles and to replace equipment, aircraft  
18 navigational and communications equipment, video cameras for  
19 patrol vehicles and four motorcycles.

20     2. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund  
21 to the Training Division of the Department of Public Safety the sum  
22 of \$60,435 to partially fund computer hardware and software,  
23 classroom furniture and protective suits.

24     3. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund  
25 to the Investigation Division of the Department of Public Safety the  
26 sum of \$29,941 to partially fund the replacement of computer  
27 equipment and vehicles.

28     **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by  
29 sections 1 and 2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure  
30 after June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriations are  
31 made or any entity to which money from the appropriations is  
32 granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of  
33 the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any  
34 purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the  
35 money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was  
36 subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the  
37 State General Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

38     **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
